Overview: The Large Research Grants on Education Program supports education research projects that will contribute to the improvement of education (how people learn via a specific intervention/mechanism). The goal for this program is to support rigorous, intellectually ambitious and technically sound research that is relevant to the most pressing questions and compelling opportunities in education. Eligibility:

- Principal Investigators (PIs) and Co-PIs must have an earned doctorate in an academic discipline
 or professional field, or appropriate experience in an education research-related profession.
 While graduate students may be part of the research team, they may not be named the PI or
 Co-PI on the proposal.
- PIs and Co-PIs may only hold one active research grant from the Spencer Foundation at a time.

Special Requirements: Promptly submit your <u>proposal intake form</u> prior to UCSC's <u>Internal Institutional Deadlines</u>.
