

Description:

Part 2 of this assignment is to collaborate with your group members to create ONE brainstorm map. Create this map using a Web 2.0 tool such as: Creately, Google Draw, Mindomo, Wisemapping, Popplet, Google Docs or another graphic organizer. Share one document with each member of the group so everyone can edit the same assignment.

The purpose of this assignment is to exhaust all possible categories for research of your topic. Your Final Issue Group also needs to focus its attention on the 5 best questions that individual members created for analysis. Include these questions in the group mind map.

A. GROUP MIND MAP	15 points
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To receive credit for a group map :

1. The group mind map is complete and a copy has been printed and shared electronically with all members of the issue group. Printed copy must be legible and complete.
2. When showing your instructor the completed GROUP mind map, each member of the group needs to bring their INDIVIDUAL brainstorm map showing evidence of collaboration and contribution to group goals.
3. 5 questions have been included in the group mind map for inquiry and analysis.

SUBMISSION of ASSIGNMENT #1 Part 2:

Have a brief conference with your teacher and your group members. Be prepared to discuss the following during your conference:

- Why is your topic such an important problem to address?
- Who is the political, social, and economics expert in the group?
- Elaborate on your themes concepts in your mind map
- How did you create your questions?
- What will you need to find the answers to these questions?
- What relevant sources have you found thus far? How do you know they're reliable?
