## Senior Privilege Contract

Seniors planning to apply for Senior Privilege, the opportunity to arrive at school late or to leave early, must meet all of the following requirements as outlined in the Student/Parent Handbook:

1. Have senior standing and be eligible for graduation, with a Nute High School diploma, at the end of the current school year.
2. Have an 85 or better at each grading period (progress reports and report cards) for each class.
3. Demonstrate appropriate behavior at all times and not have any discipline referrals for the current semester and the previous semester.
4. Maintain an exemplary attendance record by not exceeding the attendance policy for the current semester and the previous semester.
5. Has completed all mandatory state and local testing (SAS, SATs, iReady, Exact Path etc.).

### Procedure for obtaining Senior Privilege:

1. Obtain contract from school secretary
2. Secure signature from parents (you must have parents/guardian's signature even if you are 18 years or older)
3. Meet with the guidance counselor for records review and signature
4. Submit the completed application to the front office for the Principal's final approval.

**REMEMBER: You must sign in and out upon arrival and departure from school every day. Failure to abide by the requirements and/or procedures may result in the loss of your Senior Privilege status. Students failing courses while having senior privilege will have it revoked and be required to take other classes or a guided study.**

## Junior Privilege Contract

Juniors planning to apply for Junior Privilege, the opportunity to arrive at school late or to leave early, must meet all of the following requirements as outlined in the Student/Parent Handbook:

1. Have junior status and be eligible for graduation, with a Nute High School diploma, at the end of the following school year.
2. Have earned a minimum of 14 credits (between freshman and sophomore year) - only need 10 credits over the next 2 years.
3. Have an 85 or better at each grading period (progress reports and report cards) for each class.
4. Demonstrate appropriate behavior at all times and not have any discipline referrals for the current semester and the previous semester.
5. Maintain an exemplary attendance record by not exceeding the attendance policy for the current semester and the previous semester.
6. Must carry at least 4 consecutive classes for the full year.
7. Has completed all mandatory state and local testing (SAS, SATs, iReady, Exact Path etc.).

### Procedure for obtaining Junior Privilege:

1. Obtain contract from school secretary
2. Secure signature from parents (you must have parents/guardian's signature even if you are 18 years or older)
3. Meet with the guidance counselor for records review and signature
4. Submit the completed application to the front office for the Principal's final approval.

**REMEMBER: You must sign in and out upon arrival and departure from school every day. Failure to abide by the requirements and/or procedures may result in the loss of your Junior Privilege status. Students failing courses while having junior privilege will have it revoked and be required to take other classes or a guided study.**
