FROM DOWNTOWN PITTSBURGH: Take Route 28 North to Exit 3 for Millvale. Stay straight to go onto Lincoln Avenue. 416 Lincoln Avenue is at the top of the hill on the right.

FROM THE NORTH: Take Route 8 South and merge onto Route 28 South (towards Pittsburgh). Take Exit 3 for Millvale. Stop and then go straight at the first Stop Sign. Take next right onto Lincoln Avenue. 416 Lincoln Avenue is at the top of the hill on the right.
