


BIST Year 4E Weekly Update

Literacy

Students enjoyed this familiar classic, written in 1936 about five men who misinterpret the actions of Ferdinand the bull and select him as an ideal candidate to take part in the bullfights of Madrid. Students examined the story, identified the mistakes made by the five men, and provided advice to help them avoid making the same mistakes in the future. Finally, students examined real-life photos, and tried to guess at what the "true story" could be rather than jumping to conclusions.



- We also worked this week on resetting purpose, reviewing routines and expectations, setting goals, beginning explicit science investigations, building our creative muscles, reacquainting ourselves with one another, and welcoming new members to our learning community.

 of online games and activities to help them practise. In <u>Term 2</u> we will expect the students to know
 the spelling and meaning of each word.

IPC

Students began our new IPC unit, Active Planet. In this unit students will learn that the tectonic
plates that form the Earth's crust are always moving. Even the smallest movement can cause huge
earthquakes, volcanoes, and tsunamis that can devastate communities across wide areas.
 Students will look at understanding what is happening underground to learn to predict and protect

Home Learning

• Please note our new half-term <u>Home Learning Grid</u>. Students will still have their weekly tasks coming from school each week, but they should also chose one activity per week to attempt and share with their class. The activities should be inspiring and engaging, whilst giving opportunities for children to show off their unique personalities. Mathematics

- This week focuses on mental multiplication and division strategies, which underpin the work on proper fractions that follows, including finding non-unit fractions of amounts, equivalent fractions and simplifying. Students will:
 - use mental multiplication and division strategies
 - find non-unit fractions of 2-digit and 3-digit numbers
 - find equivalent fractions and use them to simplify fractions (halves, thirds, quarters)
