Back to the Future?

On the **timeline** of great civilizations, when does yours appear? You can also choose the present day.

Connect the timing to real events and the impacts on your civilization.

Knock, Knock...Who's There?

Who lives in your civilization? How many people are there? What ages? What are the impacts of your **demographics?**

Show Me the Money?

How does your **economy** work? Trade? Innovation? Employment?

Who's the Boss?

What **political structure** (or lack of) is used? How are laws made and upheld? Are there limits?

All is Fair?

Consider ongoing and historic social issues. Do they impact your civilization or have you built a truly **equitable** society? Explain.

Head of the Class?

Is your civilization divided into **classes?** If so, can one move up (or down)? If not, how does it impact life? .

Say What?

How does your society **communicate?**

See No...Hear No?

What role does **art** (music, visual, drama, dance...) have in your civilization?

Grand Designs?

What are the **built features** your civilization has created? How do built structures interact with the natural landscape?

Believe it or Not?

Do **faith and religion** play a role in your society? Explain.

Anything Else?

Show **interest** and **originality** in your ideas!
