YouTube: How to Post!

Posting your video on YouTube is a great alternative to posting it directly to Google Classroom.

It won't take as long to process, allows students to change the quality for slower bandwidth, and students are familiar with the YouTube platform.

Log in to your School Youtube Account youtube.com





Click the little video camera with the plus sign on it (in the top right corner, next to your waffle)




You will have two options: Upload from your computer or "Go live"

An upload box will appear. Choose the video you want to upload.





Once you've selected your video, the box to the left pops up. Give your video a title. You can add a description as well.







Underneath the title and description, you'll see the following options:

Thumbnail: Choose what the still image preview of the video will look like

Playlists: Create a new playlist to organize your videos or add to a current one

Audience: Make sure you have "Yes, it's made for kids" checked!

When you're done, click the next button.






