- **Examples**:

Singular: There is a hospital near my house.

Plural: There are two supermarkets in my neighborhood.

- **Pronunciation Focus:** Plural -s endings
 - /s/ sound: parks, shops
 - /z/ sound: hotels, cars
 - /iz/ sound: places, churches


