BUSINESS AND NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

DISPOSITION OF SCHOOL PROPERTY

The Board of Education considers it a good management practice to discard any pieces of school furniture, equipment, or supplies that are impossible to repair, more costly to repair than replace, and/or no longer usable in connection with any of the school system's education programs. The administration, therefore, is authorized to dispose of such furniture in accordance with the following regulations.
