

Posting on the KQED ESL Mobile News Blog

1. Go to www.blogger.com and login
2. Click **NEW POST**
3. **TITLE:** Create a catchy and interesting title.
4. In the box, add your **byline**:
by (first and last name), City College of San Francisco ESL Student
5. Add an **IMAGE**

 - Spacing
 - Grammar, Spelling, Punctuation
8. Click **PUBLISH POST**. Now other students can read it.
9. Read and **comment** on at least 3 other posts.
