# ISD #314 Flight 707 Care 2024-2025 School Year Mondays ONLY!

Beginning the '23-'24 school year, school will start one hour later (9:00 a.m. vs. 8:00 a.m.) every Monday. When considering bus pick-ups, etc. simply add one hour to the time your child is normally picked up. All other weekdays will be at our regular (8:00 a.m.) start time. The ending time of the school day (3:00 p.m.) will NOT change. Flight 707 Care is an optional program offered to families who may choose to drop off their K-6 children starting at 7:30 a.m. Mondays.

#### Who may attend?

• Braham Area School students in grades K-6 are eligible to attend Flight 707 Care.

### When is Flight 707 Care open?

• MONDAYs ONLY during the '23-'24 school year from 7:30 a.m. to the start of the school day.

#### What is the cost to attend Flight 707 Care?

• There is no cost for Braham Area School K-6 students to attend.

#### What about students in PreK or students in grades 7-12?

• PreK students and 7-12 grade students may enter school district buildings no earlier than 8:45 a.m. on Mondays during the school year. These students are not eligible for Flight 707 Care.

# **Are there other options?**

• Before and After School Kare (BASK), a long running program at ISD #314, is available. BASK is fee based for PreK-6 students starting at 6:30 a.m. until the start of the school day and again after school until 6:00 p.m. BASK is located in the PreK-3 building. See our website for more information and to register.

# I plan to have my children attend Flight 707 Care. What do I need to know?

\*Flight 707 Care is only offered on Mondays during the regular school year.

\*Flight 707 Care is open for Braham Area School students in grades K-6.

\*Flight 707 Care is located at the 4-12 building (HS). Entrance is only through door #12, located on the north side of the building, accessible from the new parking lot.

\*Parents MUST sign their children up EACH week they plan to attend.

#### Do I have to sign my child(ren) up each Monday they plan to attend?

- YES. You must sign up participating children by 10:00 a.m. the prior Friday. *If school is not in session the prior Friday due to a vacation day, sign up is the last school day of that particular week.*
- ONLY CHILDREN WHO ARE SIGNED UP <u>ON TIME</u> WILL BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND FLIGHT 707 CARE (this is to ensure we have appropriate levels of staffing).
  - Students dropped off who are not signed up:
    - On first offense will be sent to the Superintendent's office and parents will be notified.
    - A second offense will result in a 60 day suspension from Flight 707 Care.
    - A third offense will result in the revocation of Flight 707 Care privileges for the school year.

# What if I sign my children up for Flight 707 Care and they do not attend?

- A first offense will result in parent notification.
- A second offense will result in a 30 day suspension from Flight 707 Care.
- A third offense will result in a 90 day suspension from Flight 707 Care.

#### What will my children be doing at Flight 707 Care?

- Option 1: Children may utilize the gymnasium for circuit walking. Music will be playing and ONLY walking
  will be allowed. At the discretion of the supervisor, students may be taken outdoors and utilize the playground
  area at the baseball complex.
- Option 2: Children may engage in quiet activities hosted in the cafeteria. Activities may include board games, coloring, homework area, and child-friendly TV.

## May students have breakfast?

All students will be offered a free breakfast.

# What are behavior expectations?

• Children will be expected to behave appropriately. Attending Flight 707 Care is a privilege and the right to attend may be revoked at any time by building administration.

# What is the exact process?

- 1. You must sign up for each and every Monday your child(ren) plans to attend. The sign up is on the district website under the Flight 707 tab. The deadline to sign up is 10:00 a.m. the Friday prior (*if there is no school that Friday, sign up is the last school day of that particular week*).
- 2. NO EARLIER than 7:30 a.m. on Mondays when school is in session, drop your K-6 grade child(ren) off at door #12 of the 4-12 (HS) building. Door #12 is located on the north side of the building and can be accessed from the new parking lot. To ensure safety, children **must** check in with Braham Area School Staff upon arrival.
- 3. K-3 students will be bussed (bus #15) to the PreK-3 building at the end of each session of Flight 707 Care.
