Examination Timetable The examination timetable is attached to this email and posted on the school portal under QuickLinks. **Check your exam dates and times carefully.**

Times Examinations are two hours unless otherwise stated. Be at your exam 20 minutes before it starts.

Morning Exams: 9.00am-11.00am (be there by 8.40am)

Afternoon Exams: 1.30pm-3.30pm (be there by 1.10pm)

Exam Venues

- The Old Gymnasium is the main examination centre. Meet on the Tennis Courts.
- Technology and Art exams are in C Block. Note: the Technology and Art exams are supervised work sessions.

Students with Special Assessment Conditions are to meet on the old gym deck 20 minutes prior to the start of the examination. LEU will organise your exam clashes.

Listen to the Instructions As several subjects may be examined in one venue, please listen carefully to the instructions regarding entry/exit into and out of the Gym. Students who are sitting examinations in the Gym are to line up on the tennis courts prior to the examination.

Uniform GREYS - Correct school winter uniform must be worn to the examinations. The normal school rules apply to shaving and jewellery.

Exam Materials All equipment must be brought into the exam in a **clear plastic bag**. Students are responsible for taking the correct equipment to the exam and making sure that it is working.

You can bring:

1. Pens (**black** and **blue** colours **only** are permitted, pencils and an eraser.
2. An approved calculator for subjects where a calculator has been used in the subject during the year. (You cannot keep notes or routines in the memory of calculators – these will be cleared.)
3. Only water, in a **small** clear bottle, may be consumed during an examination. Note: water must be in a clear bottle with no labels. No food is to be eaten in any room.

Banned items:

- blank paper or refill paper
- correcting fluid
- books, written notes or electronic notes
- cell phones or pagers

- English dictionaries, foreign language dictionaries, or Te Reo Maaori dictionaries or translators
- watches of any type (digital or analogue)
- any electronic device which has the capability to store, communicate and/or retrieve information except approved calculators.

Attendance

- **All** students must sit their exams.
- Rolls will be checked at the commencement of each exam. The school needs to be advised promptly of any non-attendance at an exam. Contact will be made with parents if there are any unexplained absences from examinations.
- Sick? A note/medical certificate of explanation is required for any non-attendance. Absences will be followed up.
- If there is any reason why timetabled examination commitments cannot be met, please see Mr Coley **ASAP**.

Can you leave early? No - Students must stay for the designated time period of the examination and may not leave early.

Exam Clash? You should receive another email from Mrs Rayner regarding your exam clash. If you have Special Assessment Conditions, LEU will organise your exam clashes.
