- ✓ Use the text directions they give you, but check the **surrounding lines** also.
- ✓ If you're **stuck**, bookmark it, skip it and **come back later**.
- ✓ **Read ALL** of the answer choices, even if you think you've found the correct answer. There can be more than one plausible answer.
- ✓ **Eliminate** answers you know are incorrect.
- ✓ If you're not sure, make a guess that **makes sense**
- ✓ Don't change answers, unless you know you made a careless mistake. Your **first instinct** is usually correct!
- ✓ **RACE**= Restate, answer, Cite twice, End/ explain. ALL written answers are RACE answers.

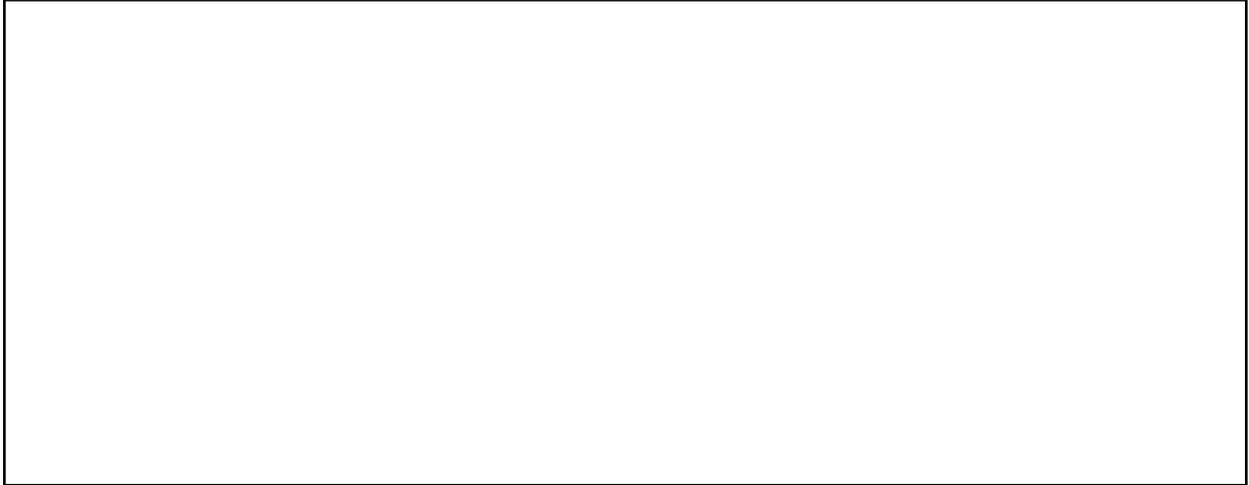

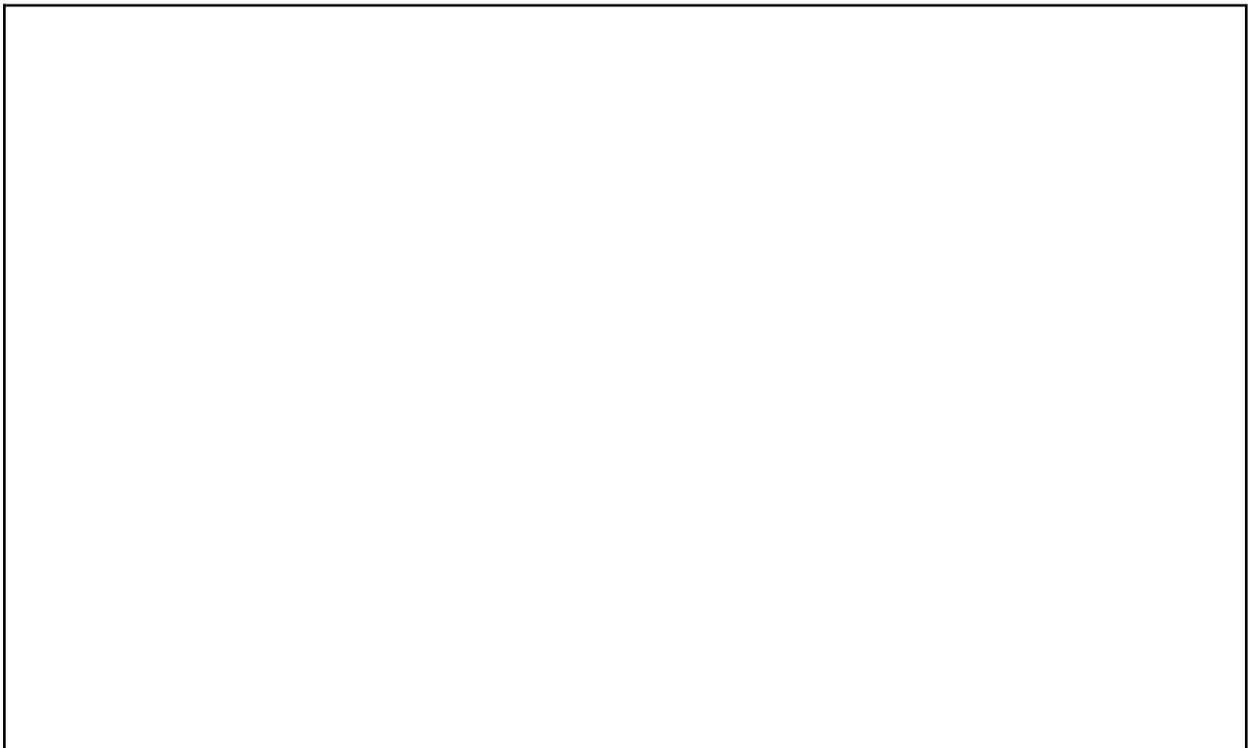
