PHS Course Outline - French 4

<u>Course Overview:</u> This course is structured to emphasize all four aspects of language learning: reading, writing, speaking and listening with a heavy emphasis on meaningful communication through an immersive and interactive environment. The class is conducted 98% in the target language, focusing on language acquisition by means of comprehensible input.

- *Students will come to class each day prepared and ready to speak and listen to the target language.

- Confidently apply circumlocution strategies
- Confidently recognize language different time frames
