



Wrexhammer Tournament 2nd December 2023

The tournament will be a 2000pt matched play tournament using current GW match play rules and any Index/codex's/balanced sheets released up to (and including) 24th November (a week before).

All lists should be submitted by 5pm 24th November – submission format is via email to y2kevlar@googlemail.com

The tournament will be played over 3 missions lasting 2hr 45 mins each with random pairings for the first round and swiss pairing there after.

The missions will be randomly draw on the Wednesday and posted along with pairings and army lists.

The winner will be decided by wins followed by total victory points across the 3 missions.

The schedule for the day is a follows

Venue opens: 11.00

First Game: 11.30 – 2.15

Lunch break: 2.15 – 2.45

Second game: 2.45 – 5.30

Third Game: 5.45 – 8.30

Awards: 8.35

Missions and Terrain

We will be using WTC Terrain and mission set ups for all missions.

Mission 1 – Scorched Earth – Chilling rain – search and destroy.

Mission 2 – Priority Targets – Chilling rain – Sweeping Engagement.

Mission 3 – Supply drop – Chilling rain – Hammer and Anvil

Lists

All lists should be submitted by 5pm 24th November to the following email address y2kevlar@googlemail.com using the export from the GW app (as it's free) any submitted in any other way including whats app will be ignored. Lists will then be checked and released when the pairing are drawn on the following Wednesday. Lists submitted after the deadline (without good reason) will be subject to penalty points of -10 pts per game.

All lists must include all Enhancements and detachments and are fixed for all missions.

All models need to be WYSIWYG – conversions are fine as long as it's obvious to your opponent what they are, proxies need to be confirmed prior to the event either via email/whatsapp or Facebook messenger.

Armies should be battle ready in order to earn the 10 pts for this, you can use non battle ready armies but this will mean you do not score the 10pts each round.

Prizes

There will be prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place as well as best painted and spot prizes – the value of prizes will depend upon the number of entrants and will be announced on the day.

Venue

The venue is a fully licenced bar and will be serving drinks and bar snacks throughout the day, please feel free to bring your own food in with you but DO NOT bring in your own drinks, we ask that only drinks purchased on site are consumed. There are lots of options locally to purchase lunch and you can also have lunch delivered from a number of local businesses.

There is free parking on site either behind or in front of the pub and cars can also be parked on the premises next door as they do not operate on a weekend.

Fair play and good attitude

The most important part of the day is everyone having fun, as such we expect all entrants to behave in a positive manner at all times, whether you're a seasoned pro or its your first game play in a friendly and inclusive manner.

Chess clocks can be requested for a game (you must bring your own), but should only be used if both players agree to their use and are comfortable with using them, in general if you are not sure call over a TO.

If you are unable to finish a game in the set time then you may if you wish talk out the remainder of your current battle round but no further.

If any disagreements occur that you cannot resolve just call over one of the TO's who will make a ruling on it.

If anyone does not adhere these standards we reserve the right to remove you from the tournament and no refund will be given.

Refunds

In the unfortunate event you are unable to attend we will only be able to refund you up until 10th November, after this point if we are able to resell your ticket we will offer a refund but in the event of your place not being filled no refund will be offered.
