English Language Arts	<p>Goal #1 PHONICS: I can identify all upper and lowercase letters and sounds</p> <p>Goal #2 READING: I can listen to stories heard and read and retell the important events that happened in logical order.</p> <p>Goal #3 WRITING: I can form upper and lowercase letters using appropriate letter formation.</p> <p>Goal #4 READING & WRITING: I can blend/segment sounds to read and spell CVC/CCVC words with the short /i/sound.</p> <p>Goal #5 READING & WRITING: to I can make, read, and write sight words</p>
Math	<p>Goal #1 MATH: I can use objects and drawings to compose and decompose 10</p> <p>Number sense encourages students to think flexibly and allows them to manipulate numbers. Students will learn to recognize that numbers are composed of smaller parts. They will notice that combinations of two addends make 10 (i.e., 3 and 7; 5 and 5). Let the students naturally discover the pattern of finding all the 11 ways to make 10. You might encourage some organization of building and/or recording.</p>
Science	<p>Goal #1 SCIENCE: I can differentiate between living and nonliving things based on whether they have basic needs & produce offspring.</p> <p>The student knows that plants and animals have basic needs and depend on things around them for survival.</p>
