

Dear Parents,

As students learn to use technology proficiently, it is also important that they are responsible digital citizens. We all want to help them make good choices online while they learn. The internet is a big place, and it's important that teachers, school administrators and parents work together to keep students safe.

MVWSD provides a tool to help parents be aware of their student's online activities. Schools use [Securly](#) to keep students safe on their school-issued devices. This application allows you to see what choices your student is making online so that you will be alerted to potential issues and can guide your student. Please note: Securly is for school-issued devices only; not your student's cell phone, family iPad, etc. Securly will give reports for online activity on your child's district-issued device that occurs off school grounds. You will not get reports for online activity at school.

There are three ways to view your child's activity at your convenience:

- To enter the web-based **Parent Portal**, simply click on the "view more" link, or the "sign up" link at the bottom of your weekly email. If you don't sign up, you will still receive the weekly Securly email. If you do not want the Securly email, you may choose "unsubscribe."
- **By Securly email:** Parents may receive an email report each Monday containing a sample of your child's online activity outside of school over the previous week. You can link from the email to the Portal to view more details, if needed.
- **SecurlyHome App:** This week, you will receive a "Welcome Email" from Securly, and you will be able to download the App.

#### Step 1: Download the SecurlyHome App from the Welcome Email



Get SecurlyHome on the go. Real-time activity reports, right in the palm of your hand.



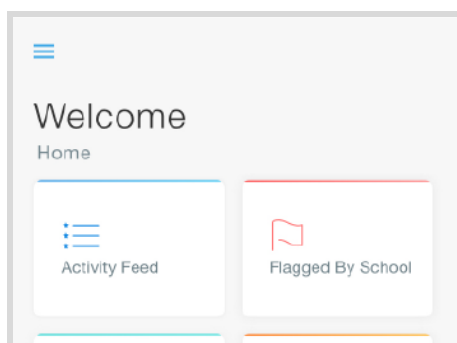
#### Step 2: Open the App and click on the "send me a link" button.

- A link will be sent to the email address you have registered with your child's school.
- Once you've clicked the link, you'll be taken to the SecurlyHome App. Your account is ready to go!

### Step 3: Explore and Configure

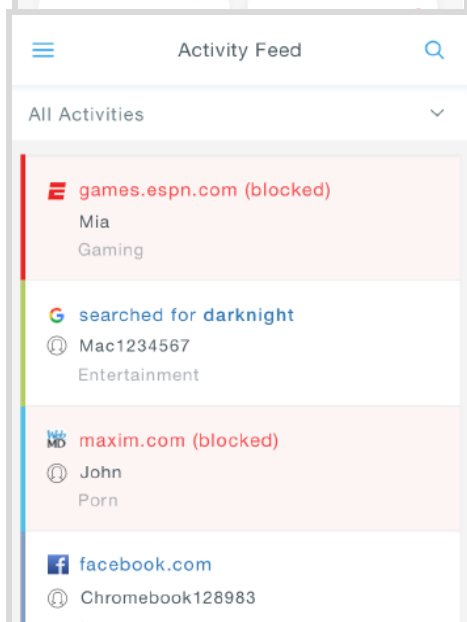
- SecurlyHome lets you access your account information from anywhere, in real-time.

#### 1. Get Started



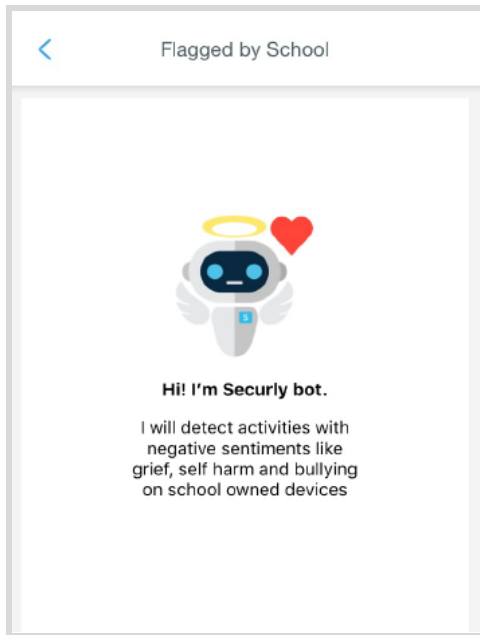
Navigate and explore different views into your child's online safety.

#### 2. Activity



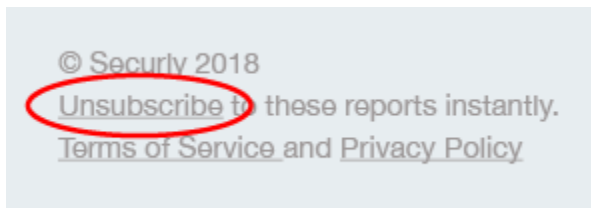
Get a real-time view of your child's online activity.
