

# 1st Mediterranean Lifesaving Championships 2024

The **Mediterranean Lifesaving Confederation** (MLC), in collaboration with the **Lifesaving Section** of the **Italian Swimming Federation** (FIN), organise the 1st Mediterranean Lifesaving Championships. It will be held in conjunction with the Italian Summer Championship at the swimming stadium of Rome. The championships are open to National Teams and Clubs.

## ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE AT THE NATIONAL TEAMS OPEN

The National Teams MLC are open to one Open team per nation of the Mediterranean List:

- Africa: Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco and Tunisia.
- Asia: Cyprus, Lebanon, Syria and Turkey.
- **Europe:** Albania, Andorra, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, France, Greece, Italy, Kosovo, Malta, Monaco, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Portugal, San Marino, Serbia, Slovenia and Spain.

To be eligible to compete on a national team, competitors shall:

- Be citizens, by birth or naturalisation, of the nation they represent and satisfy the International Olympic Committee (IOC) eligibility requirements to compete for that nation.
- Be bona fide members in good standing of the MLC member National Lifesaving Organisation (NLO) and eligible to compete as determined by the NLO.
- Participation is OPEN to competitors aged until 2007.
- The size of the team is free, but only two athletes can compete in each event. It is not mandatory to have both men and women competitors in a team.

## **ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN INTERCLUB OPEN MLC**

The athletes must be in good standing with a current MLC Member of the Mediterranean List:

- Africa: Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco and Tunisia
- Asia: Cyprus, Lebanon, Syria and Turkey.
- **Europe:** Albania, Andorra, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, France, Greece, Italy, Kosovo, Malta, Monaco, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Portugal, San Marino, Serbia, Slovenia and Spain.
- The Interclub MLC are open to one team per club.
- All be athletes of the same lifesaving club, or lifesaving "unit" of a NLO that is an MLC member and not a composite team from multiple clubs or units.
- Participation is OPEN to competitors aged until 2007.
- The size of the team is free, but only two athletes can compete in each event. It is not mandatory to have both men and women competitors in a team.

**Technical Rules:** The <u>ILS Competition Rules</u> will apply to the championships. **Relays:** Each nation and club may enter one female and one male relay **Ranking:** Two rankings will be drawn up: one for nations and one for clubs

### Registration:

- The appropriate excel registration form must be received until 9/07/2024, via mail: giorgiana.emili@federnuoto.it and elagreece@gmail.com
- Italian clubs must indicate, for each event, which athletes are lined up for the Mediterranean Lifesaving Championship.
- Individual competitions will take place in the morning and relays in the afternoon.
- Athletes will compete divided into the age categories according to the Italian regulations, but then a single open ranking list will be drawn up.
- The competition fee is 15€/competitor.

## **Transportation**

Teams are responsible for their transportation:

- Airports: <u>Fumicino</u> and <u>Champino</u>.
- Train: Leonardo Express. Available every 15'. Cost: 8-14€.
- Taxi: For 3 persons with luggages or 4 persons with no luggages about 50-55€
