The final paragraph of this section contains the Community Service objectives to be achieved. The introduction contains a maximum of 20% of the entire manuscript. METHOD (Times New Roman 12pt, bold, spasi 1,15, left)

This section contains a brief description of the partner profile: Who? Where? How many people are involved? Gender and age of participants, stages of the method used in carrying out activities/PkM to solve problems. Implementation steps: (1) Activity Preparation; (2) Activity (State the name of the activity, Time, Material, Speaker); (3) Monitoring and Evaluation (using questionnaires, interviews, observations, etc.). The

evaluation in question can be in the form of monitoring results during the activity and evaluation of conditions before and after PkM. (Times New Roman 12pt, 1.15 spacing, justify). 2. Subtitles (According to Activity Stages)

Explained according to the flow of the solution offer or steps in the Implementation Method section; (1) Description of what has been done, (2) followed by documentation photos (not group photos), (3) further explanation. Each Figure or Table is referred to in the paragraph before or after it. (Figure 1, Table 1, ...)

1. Monitoring and Evaluation

Monitoring: what was done during the activity (such as observation results, questionnaire results). This section should discuss the results of the test or questionnaire, especially the percentage increase that occurred before or after the activity.

2. Obstacles Encountered or Other Issues Recorded

Includes suggested solutions. References should be written using the Mendeley application, using APA style, 7th edition (Emilia Duarte & Carlos Rosa, 2019) (Times New Roman 12pt, spasi 1,15, justify). Writing or referencing written references using the Mendeley application, select APA style edition 7 (Klau & Frans, 2019; Mashuri, 2017).

Table titles are written sequentially in Times New Roman, 11pt font, 1.15 spacing, centered. Table titles are written at the top of the table in Times New Roman, 11pt font, bold, 1.15 spacing, centered.
