Despite condemning Israel for their rebellion and folly, God promises triumph over the power of death and the grave.

"You are destroyed, Israel, because you are against me, against your helper. Where is your king, that he may save you? Where are your rulers in all your towns, of whom you said, 'Give me a king and princes'?

So in my anger I gave you a king, and in my wrath I took him away. The guilt of Ephraim is stored up, his sins are kept on record. Pains as of a woman in childbirth come to him, but he is a child without wisdom; when the time arrives,

he doesn't have the sense to come

out of the womb.

"I will deliver this people from the power of the grave;

I will redeem them from death.

Where, O death, are your plagues? Where, O grave, is your destruction?

THE SECOND LESSON 1 Corinthians 15:35-49

Paul affirms that the resurrection will transform the perishable body into an imperishable, spiritual body which bears the image of Christ.

But someone will ask, "How are the dead raised? With what kind of body will they come?" How foolish! What you sow does not come to life unless it dies. When you sow, you do not plant the body that will be, but just a seed, perhaps of wheat or of something else. But God gives it a body as he has determined, and to each kind of seed he gives its own body. Not all flesh is the same: People have one kind of flesh, animals have another, birds another and fish another. There are also heavenly bodies and there are earthly bodies; but the splendor of the heavenly bodies is one kind, and the splendor of the earthly bodies is another. The sun has one kind of splendor, the moon another and the stars another; and star differs from star in splendor.

So will it be with the resurrection of the dead. The body that is sown is perishable, it is raised imperishable; it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body.

If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. So it is written: "The first man Adam became a living being"; the last Adam, a life-giving spirit. The spiritual did not come first, but the natural, and after that the spiritual. The first man was of the dust of the earth; the second man is of heaven. As was the earthly man, so are those who are of the earth; and as is the heavenly man, so also are those who are of heaven. And just as we have borne the image of the earthly man, so shall we bear the image of the heavenly man.

Reader: This is the Word of the Lord.

THE HOLY GOSPEL John 20:1-10

Seeing the evidence in the empty tomb, the other disciple was the first to see and believe in the resurrection.

Early on the first day of the week, while it

was still dark, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the entrance. So she came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved, and said, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him!"

So Peter and the other disciple started for the tomb. Both were running, but the other disciple outran Peter and reached the tomb first. He bent over and looked in at the strips of linen lying there but did not go in. Then Simon Peter came along behind him and went straight into the

tomb. He saw the strips of linen lying there, as well as the cloth that had been wrapped around Jesus' head. The cloth was still lying in its place, separate from the linen. Finally the other disciple, who had reached the tomb first, also went inside. He saw and believed. (They still did not understand from Scripture that Jesus had to rise from the dead.) Then the disciples went back to where they were staying.

Questions for the Week: Together: Resurrection

- 1. The sermon used the "Devil Went Down to Georgia" analogy, contrasting the Devil's chaotic music with Johnny's beauty. Where do you see "chaos" (selfishness, division) and "beauty" (grace, life) at work in the world or in the church today?
- 2. Read 1 Corinthians 15:34-49. Paul called the Corinthians to "Wake up from your drunken stupor" and stop sinning. What is one area where we have been acting "asleep" or blinded by individualism (like the Corinthians), and what is one practical way we can intentionally choose to build *each other* up this week instead?
- 3. Paul reminds us that in Christ, "Death is swallowed up in victory." What does this victory mean for our family when we face something that feels permanent, difficult, or like a "loss" right now? How does the promise of resurrection change how we view these earthly problems?

4. Christ defeats ugliness with beauty. What is one concrete action we can take this week to bring the "beauty" of Christ's forgiveness and life into a chaotic situation or to a person in need?

Cris's weekly input: Sermon Summary: Main Idea, Key Points, and Questions:

Pastor Cris's Summary:

The sermon uses the song "The Devil Went Down to Georgia" as an analogy for Christ's victory over chaos.

The core message, based on **1 Corinthians 15**, is that Jesus's resurrection defeats the devil, death, and sin, proclaiming: **"O death, where is your victory?"**

The preacher notes that the Corinthians and modern society share a chaotic, individualistic focus on self-greatness—a "drunken stupor"—that prioritizes "doing what I want" over building up others, which brings hurt and division.

Jesus's resurrection replaces this chaos and the **perishable** world with **imperishable beauty**. Just as Johnny's beautiful song defeated the Devil's chaotic noise, Jesus's work—from calling disciples to rising from the grave—is a continuous act of bringing **beauty** and new life to the world's ugliest situations.

The sermon concludes by urging listeners to unite in Christ's victory and go out to **bring this beauty to those in chaos.**
