Able to see their way through problems, honest, and have integrity. Shows school, community, and church involvement. Could be seeking training, certification, or a degree. Possibly starting their own local business

If criteria are needed to separate candidates: 1) Character and need 2) Potential impact on their chosen career field

FINAL SELECTION:

The faculty will nominate up to 4 candidates from the applications. The final decision will be made by the family of Connie Burgardt

A scholarship would be given at the completion of the first semester with proof of enrollment or program completion, whichever applies
