

Outdoor Adventure Birthday Card

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Outdoor Adventure Bundle (168009); Banner Sayings Bundle (167051)
- **Paper** –Thick Basic White (159229); Basic White (168780); Basic Black (121045)
- **Stamp Pads** – VersaMark (102283); Early Espresso (147114); Old Olive (147090); Pool Party (147107)
- **Misc.** – Birch Wood Embossing Folder (164069); Basic Black Stampin' Blends (154843); Linen Thread (104199); Blending Brushes (153611); Basics WOW! Embossing Powders (165679); Rainbow Adhesive Backed Dots (162758); Heat Tool (129053); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149635); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

Measurements:

- Thick Basic White: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic White: 4" x 5-1/4" (x2) one embossed with the Birch Wood EF and the other for stamping
- Basic Black: scrap
- Linen Thread: 8"

Instructions :

1. Using scissors, distress around the edges of the embossed layer of card stock.
2. Use a blending brush and pool party ink and add a bit of color to the center of the embossed layout.
3. Splatter using the brush tip of the black Stampin' Blend and a bone folder. Add layer to the card front.

4. Stamp the cluster of trees onto the second piece of white card stock. Use full strength old olive for two of them and the third one stamped off so that it's a bit lighter. Die cut all three using the coordinating die.
5. Add the trees to the card front as shown.
6. Stamp the buck using espresso ink onto the white cardstock and die cut. Add it to the card front using dimensionals.
7. Stamp desired greeting using VersaMark ink onto the black cardstock.
8. Sprinkle with white embossing powder and heat set.
9. Punch out using the three banner punch.
10. Tie a bow from the linen thread and add it to the card front.
11. Add greeting.
12. Finish off with three pool party or lost lagoon dots.
