

# What would you like to see this Committee work on in 2026?

- Tips and Tricks Guide for Credit and Credit Score or Appealing a Housing Denial
  - Additional topics: (1) Create a 1-pager with action steps and legal organizations if one receives an eviction notice; (2) Create a list of landlords who accept formerly incarcerated people, as well as a list of free healthcare orgs. Share those lists with local jails and prisons.
  - Informational, not just a resource guide or list of phone numbers
  - What is a pay or quit notice explainer
- Research Project: What are the questions that are unanswered? Targeted prevention model provides an anchor, but not everyone is well served by it (for example, older adults). Do the work of exploring models that serve those populations and work with partners to understand how to weave that into the core practices of targeted prevention.
- How are we engaging with and letting people know about prevention resources? How are we connecting with folks? Promoting prevention programs. Marketing - what spaces are we going into so that they know the resources are available?
  - How to knowledge - how do we distribute information? Mapping and maintaining how we distribute information.
  - Are we responsible for creating the materials that are distributed or are we responsible for the distribution strategy? Committee members can leverage their networks and organizations to distribute.
  - Hearing from people with lived experience and those at risk of homelessness where we are *not* reaching. For example, McKinney-Vento Liaisons in the schools need to know these resources.
  - Intentional distribution and focused on who needs it
