Farm Fresh Favorites

Grades: 1st - 3rd OR 4th - 6th

Description - In this hands-on course, students will explore the delicious world of cooking with seasonal ingredients! Each week, students will learn about different fruits, vegetables, and other foods that are at their best during each season. Through fun and simple cooking projects, they'll discover how to create tasty and nutritious dishes that celebrate the flavors of the time of year. Students will gain practical skills in the kitchen, from basic knife skills and measuring to understanding how to follow recipes and experiment with new ingredients. projects like knitting, crochet, weaving & sewing. This hands-on class will teach basic skills in

Creative Composers

Grades: 6th-8th

Description: In this class, students will have the opportunity to create their own songs, lyrics

and music! We will explore different types of music and song forms as well as the "anatomy" of

a song and how to "build" a song. We will utilize instruments, voices, and technology (Garage

Band and Chrome Music Lab on school Ipads) to practice writing lyrics, beats, and melodies. We

will also collaborate to create songs in small groups, as well as a whole class. We will also learn

about some select composers and songwriters from various times in history and the present,

and their different styles of music. The students in this class will have the option to perform

their songs at Open House at the end of the semester! *The material covered in this class is

most suitable for students who already have some facility on an instrument such as piano,

ukulele, percussion voice, etc. (but NOT required) and basic musical knowledge. Reading

music is also helpful but is not required.

Destination Imagination

Grades: 7th - 8th

Description: In Destination Imagination, students work collaboratively in teams to creatively

solve open-ended, STEAM-focused challenges, developing critical thinking, problem-solving, and

teamwork skills by designing and presenting innovative solutions to complex problems. The

experience builds up to a thrilling regional competition where teams showcase their ideas and

celebrate their hard work. This class will take up 2 class periods so students have enough time

to solve the challenges. Their work will culminate in February/March with the competition,

after which students will participate in other engaging STEAM activities.

Digital Art & Photography +

Description: Middle School students are welcome to join Musical Theatre as performers along

with the rest of our student population to put on "The Rockin' Tale of Snow White". However,

middle school students also have the option of applying to participate in the rehearsal process

as one of the following technical theatre positions: Stage Manager or Dance Captain.

As Stage Manager, you will be responsible for taking notes during rehearsal on

entrances, exits, and overall stage blocking. You will also help note what props,

costumes, light cues, etc. are needed as we progress through the script. For our live

performance you will continue your role as stage manager either running the show from

the booth or backstage depending on what the production requires.

As Dance Captain, you will work closely with Miss Hayley to create and teach the

HSC Choir

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: Choir brings voices together in unison (and harmony)! This is a class for students of all skill levels to experience singing in an ensemble, while developing their unique voices. Each class begins with vocal warm-ups, which help students learn basic healthy singing techniques. We will sing traditional children's choir literature as well as a fun mix of Broadway and/or pop/ rock. Musicianship skills will also be introduced such as singing with dynamics, following conductor cues, counting beats/measures, phrasing and other expressive elements. Singing rounds and partner songs will help students develop listening and harmonic skills. Experience reading music is beneficial, but not required. Reading words is helpful, but also not required for enrolling in this class. Choir performs at the Open House held at the end of each semester.

Ukulele 1

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: This is an introductory class designed for students who have very little to no

experience with ukulele. Students will begin to build many skills including: playing with good

tone, strumming with a focus on rhythm, and beginning finger-picking. Students will learn basic

musicianship skills such as counting beats/ measures, meter/ time signatures, and reading

chord charts. Students will begin to master a minimum of 4 chords which can be used to

accompany a wide variety of songs. Singing and playing will be highly encouraged! This class

will perform as an ensemble at Open House at the end of the semester. **Students are

Musical Theatre

Grades: 1st - 8th

Fee: Tickets to attend the Musical will be available for purchase in the spring.

Description: HSC's DRAMA and MUSIC departments are joining forces to put on "**The Rockin' Tale of Snow White**"! We will combine talents by incorporating dancing, singing, and acting into

one larger than life musical production. Students will experience what a traditional rehearsal process is like in class before performing in a full production of their musical around the end of April/Beginning of May. This class is 100% performance-focused and students should be

prepared to rehearse each day they come to class.

Requirements: This is a year-long class and will rely heavily on attendance. Please advise teachers of any planned absences ahead of time. Mystery Makers

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: In Mystery Makers, students will work together to create their very own original

twists before turning those ideas into a script (with the help of Ms. Hayley). After our script is

written, students will spend the rest of the semester rehearsing and developing their acting

skills. On the final day of the semester, at our Open House celebration, students will share what

they've been working on!

Puppets, Masks, and Mimes, oh my!

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: In this class, students will learn about more specific acting situations: acting with

masks, acting with puppets, and miming! Students will explore how to communicate emotion,

character, and storyline while working in these specialized acting situations. Students will also

get the chance to design and create their own masks and puppets with which they will perform

in class. This class will not perform at Open House, however if students choose to have their

performances filmed they will be shared with family.

Technical Theatre

Grades: 4th - 6th

Description: Are you interested in theatre, but don't want to be onstage? Join other students to

explore the following technical elements of theatre: Set design, Costume design, Light design,

Sound design, Props design, Marketing, and House Management. Students will learn what each

technical element is, why it is important, and spend some time exploring and creating their own

designs for each area. Students will also help prepare and run various school wide events

scheduled during each semester. The biggest focus in this class is working on various projects

needed for the Spring Musical. There are high expectations in this class for good behavior and a

sense of responsibility when helping run our school wide events.

Kindergarten - Drama with Miss Hayley

In Drama with Miss Hayley, kindergarteners will work on being brave, working together, and expressing themselves creatively through acting-based exercises. take flight on a thrilling exploration of aerodynamics and engineering. Students will be


challenged to design and build a variety of aircraft, from rockets to helicopters and drones,

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: In this class, students will have the opportunity to learn the basics of technology through fun, engaging lessons. Basic skills will include logging into a computer, using a mouse, finding letters on the keyboard, and much more. After students have become comfortable with these basic skills, they will then be introduced to a variety of technology applications such as Sublimation, 3D Designing, a few robots, and various differing software using the laptops and

iPads. They will explore new interests on this exciting "tour" of technology! This class is a great
