Treat opposing coaches, participants, and spectators with respect.	
☐ Instruct participants in sportsmanship and demand that they display good	
sportsmanship.	
☐ Coach in a positive manner and do not use derogatory comments or abusive	
language.	
Win with humility and lose with dignity.	
☐ Treat every athlete fairly, justly, impartially, intelligently, and with sensitivity.	
☐ Always place the well-being, health, and safety of swimmers above all other	
considerations, including developing performance.	
Continue to seek and maintain their own professional development in all areas ir	1
relation to coaching and teaching children.	
Always maintain a professional separation between coach and athlete.	
When representing MAC at a swim meet, education conference or other work re	ated
outing, please wear your MAC attire.
