    - SB: Seems to be ready to me. + 2 reviewers have said it's OK
  - Issue [#2213](#): att.dataable.custom is under-documented — now on 4.5.0 milestone
  - Issue [#2110](#)
    - the anchors should be removed in the parallel approach; implement the nested example as suggested by K. Nagasaki as an alternative approach.
  - Issue [#2070](#)
    - Brief discussion yields desire to try to fix processing (maybe for this release) and corrigible errors in release notes; and perhaps raise a ticket for whether or not we actually want to re-generate release notes every build.

  - Is there a linkchecker for the TEI website?
  - Sections for internally developed resources as well as links to external resources.
  - i18n group is also thinking of introductory materials which should be linked from internationalized landing pages.
- Issues from previous SVF2F meeting
  - Lengthy test of adding namespaced attributes in response to [#2069](#) and [#237 comment](#). **Action on SB** by 2022-04-07: attach test ODD to ticket. We need to look at this with the full group.
  - Discuss issues arising from the request to offer citation buttons / bookmarks: tension between human readable and significant citation, e.g. TEI Guidelines, Reference for element 'abbr', Example 3 vs using a generated example id, direct bookmark link; latest vs fixed version (permalink)
