Instructions on Using the Inventory of Books

Organized alphabetically categories of books & maps as follows:

- **(BL/HIST)** Black History Books relating to black or African genealogy
- (BRITISH) British Self explanatory
- (CANADA) Canada self explanatory
- (COLL) Collections Various sets of books. This section is completely arbitrary and will not be changed
- (FAM/HIST) Family Histories Anything to do with Family History
- (GEN/US/CAN) General Refers to General knowledge regarding the United States
- (INTL) International Everything else
- (MAP/CASE) Maps
- (NAT/AMER) Native American Relating to Indians or tribes native to North America
- (**OVERSIZE**) Oversize Books too big to fit on standard shelves
- (REF) Reference Covers a wide range of subjects
- **(SP/COLL)** Special Collections These books are over one hundred years old. Sets bridging the 100 year mark are in Special Collections.
- (US/CAN) United States & Canada Includes States by regions.
- Withdrawn, Available Online These are no longer on our shelves with a few exceptions. They are indicated by the phrases: Withdrawn available online or Storage in the notes column.

Spreadsheet has five columns: Call Number, Title, Author, Year, and Notes.

- Call Number. This is the letters and numbers assigned to each specific book when they
 are cataloged. In Notes (shown below) lists the book as Available, the call number will be
 used to find it on our shelves.
- **Title**: Every effort has been made to include the complete title. It can be searched by using keywords or any part of the title.
- **Author**: Only the main author has been listed. Author's surname is an excellent way to find a book.
- **Year**: gives the year of publication as well as copyright (c) status.
- Notes: There are Five possible notes.
 - 1. Available: means we have the book on our shelves.
 - 2. Available online: images are available through the FamilySearch catalog.
 - 3. **Withdrawn Available online**: The book is no longer on our shelves and the images are available through the FamilySearch catalog.
 - 4. **Storage**: The book is available online and is still on our shelves.
 - 5. **Missing, presumed lost**. The availability of the book has to be determined.

To search and find books open the Inventory of Books Spreadsheet found under the Resources tab on the Center Resources under *lasvegasfsc.org*. Within the document Hold Control key (**Ctrl**) and press the **"F"** key. A window opens in the upper right. Type in your desired search. Use the up and down arrow keys to move through the spreadsheet.
