INTRODUCTION (5-10 minutes)

- Introduce the lesson
- Awaken prior knowledge
- Try state outcomes of the lessons(what you expect from them)

DEVELOPMENT (30-35 minutes)

- Teach the lesson
- Go in-depth with the new topic
- Give materials for lesson, provide links to other subjects or topics.

Consolidation (5-10 minutes)

- (wrap up the lesson)
- Add in anything interesting like a closing fun fact
- Add in an interesting fact about the topic you teaching
- Ask questions that lead learners to the answers to estimate how much they have learnt and remember.

Reflection

- Reflect on the lesson
- Reflect on what you can do better
- Reflect on whether you reached the outcomes of the lesson

THINGS TO CONSIDER

1. Integration with other subjects (one or two paragraphs)
2. Prescribed outcomes are found in your caps document
 - Are your general aims and specific aims that you find in caps.
 - Find aims and choose one and then explain it in a broad manner.
 - Specific aims in your CAPS document, you choose 1 and explain why you chose it and how it links to your topic in your ATP.

A TIP TO LEARN AND APPLY -Integrated skills:

Having integrated skills helps you plan your lesson step by step.

Are they learning how to read/listen/write/speak?

You need to explain why you choose that skill AND why it will benefit the learner.
