Washington to the Continental Congress, Dec. 25, 1779

".... Elizabeth Burgin, an inhabitant of New York...testimony of different persons, particularly many of our officers who have returned from captivity, it would appear that she has been indefatigable (tireless) for the relief of the Prisoners, and in measures for the facilitation (made possible) of their escape. In consequence of this conduct she incurred (attracted) the suspicions of the enemy, and compelled to make her escape, under the distressed circumstances which she describes. I could not forbear recommending to consideration, a person who has risked so much and been so friendly to our officers... I take the liberty of directing the Commissary at Philadelphia to furnish her and her children with rations (food and supplies)..."
