# The New Camp Site for Gulf Wars (2016) Elder Brother Brannith Marius of House Marius

There are some points that we will need to cover for the "permanent" camp site.

- Property Taxes We will, as group, have to pay property taxes. I would propose that all who (consistently) camp there pay their share of the property tax each year.
- Shower house The only bad part about the new location is that we will be further away from the showers. Many of us have talked about building (or buying) a shower house for the site. This could be one of the small portable types (even the



tent type sold at Wal-mart) for the site. This will need to be figured out before Gulf Wars 2016.

- **Pre-register** We have gotten past our "3 year probationary period" but we still need to get our required pre-registrants, which is 20 each year. Rember, any person(s) camping with our group MUST pre-register.
- **Preparing the site** If all goes as planned we will be (possibly) arriving a day early to start fixing up the site. We can use all of the help that can be offered. Everyone camping needs to help in some way.
- Any members of the shire are welcome to camp at the site, but you must pre-register and the "group camping with" will be Marius.

# **How to Pass your Device**

Jared Alexandre Blaydeaux, Pursuivant, formerly of Caid

"Hello, my name is Jared and I'm a recovering Herald."

[room responds] " . . . Hi, Jared!"

We're going to address here how to design and create an heraldic device (NOT a "coat-of-arms" – that's something else, usually a garment bearing your device), for use in the SCA. No, these rules are not exceedingly "period", because different nations throughout



history have used different rules. These are the ones which have been agreed upon in the SCA.

Things have gotten a lot more complicated since I first joined the SCA, [mumble] years ago. My name and device passed the College of Arms (they who decide such things) at the January meeting in Anno Societatis VIII (January, 1974). There weren't as many members then. My own membership number is 8028. I understand numbers are in six digits now. So, yeah, my device is middle-aged.

Why is it so hard to find a device that will pass the College of Arms? Simple, after 50 years, there are probably more than a few people who have had the ineffable good taste to want the exactly the same thing that you do. For instance, as of the last report, there are nearly 2600 devices that have a rose incorporated as part of their device. Think about that. How many variations or combinations must there be in order to avoid conflict? Those are called "points of difference", and you have to have a particular number of them to avoid conflict with someone else's device. I had to give my own son a "Permission to Conflict" letter, because he wanted a device that looked kind of like mine, but with a golden axe across the annulet diagonally, instead of across it.

So, here's what you do:

Start by listing your favorite animals, flowers, colors, objects or whatever you want on your device. Then, think about what they *mean* to you. This is important, because if you can't get your first choice, your consulting herald can help you find something that *means* the same thing. My former consort is REALLY good at that, but she's in Caid. I recommend you start by going here:

## **Heraldry for non-Heralds**

This will teach you some of the ins and outs. If you're confused, feel free to e-mail me at firedrake@earthlink.net and I'll give you all the help I can. If you'd like a copy of my basic heraldic coloring book, I'll be happy to send along a PDF file.

#### The simple rules are:

No "color on color" – you can have color on metal (argent or Or (see why that's important?) or metal on color or either one on a fur (heraldic furs are a little weird – let's not get into that right now).

No obviously modern devices. The old reference was to a young lady called Snulbugga the Fairhaired, who wanted a hot pink sewing machine. Neither the color or the machine are appropriate in SCA period. You MIGHT get away with a sewing needle (threaded) on a red field, but that's likely to be as close as you get, unless you find someone more inventive than I am.

You can divide a field vertically (per pale) or horizontally (per fess), or diagonally in either direction.

#### Heraldic colors are:

Gules = Red	To which are added the metals,
Azure = Blue Vert = Green	Argent = Silver
Purpure = Purple	Or = Gold
Sable = Black	

So, start with the color you want your shield to be. Then start adding the items or symbols you want. Don't make it too complicated: remember, you're going to be painting this on shields or sewing it on banners or garb for a long time. Then check the SCA Ordinary and Armorial here:

to see if you conflict with anyone else. This may take you a few tries. Then contact your local herald to see if they'll help you submit it. I don't know who the nearest official one is. I haven't talked to the Kingdom herald about myself, and my heraldic "rank" is from Caid.

In my case, my device is what's called a "canting" device. Meaning, it's a visual pun on my name, Jared Blaydeaux.

"Sable, an annulet vert fimbriated argent, overall a sword fesswise point to sinister Or." This means "On a black field, an annulet (circle), fimbriated )bordered argent (silver) overall, a sword fesswise (horizontally across the whole annulet), point to sinister (to the left – as one is holding a shield), Or

(gold). Why is "Or" capitalized? It's a metal, and we want to distinguish it from the word "or". Think of "herald-eze" as a programming language, and you're on the right track. It has to be precise. In fact, the description of my device has changed 3 times in 41 years, as the College of Arms has gotten more and more meticulous.

Here's what it looks like. Ignore the blue-and-white ribbon and pendant with the crescents, the helm with pearls and the mantling. Those are for matters of rank, and for another time, but here's the device.

I'm relatively new to the Midrealm, so I don't know all the Kingdom-specific awards, or how the kingdom College of Arms does things, but I'll find out and get back to you.

#### **Agenda**

- 1. Standing Items
  - 1. Review Agenda. Agenda is OK-ed by those present
- Officer's Reports
  - 1. Knight's Marshal (Bryan) reported that there were no major changes since the last report.
- 1. We have one new authorized fighter in the shire.
- 2. The shire is trying to get some more loaner gear helmets for new fighters.
- 1. Member of the populace suggested that we need more gear for new fighters.
- Member of the populace suggested that the shire should acquire some fencing loaner gear.
- Special Report on the State of the Shire –TABLED until final draft completed.
- 1. Seneschal's report (Deputy Autocrat for Oken Hills) (Chris)
- 1. Everyone did a fantastic job with organization and execution of the event.
- We made \$30, which is fantastic as many small events are losing money.
- Member of populace suggested possibly changing this event to a day-trip as most attendees do not seem interested in camping.
- 4. Member of the populace suggested that it may be more fun to move camping event from the "dry" site, to encourage more socializing during camping hours.
- 5. Member of the populace suggested that perhaps adding a planned beverage to the feast may improve the meal.
- 1. Herald's Report (Bryan)
- 1. The Herald taught classes on heraldry at mundane schools since last report.
- 2. The Herald is way over the term limit for his office. Therefore, should there be interested parties, please consider becoming the Herald for the shire.

#### 2.5 Chatelaine's Report (Stephanie)

- 1. The chatelaine is currently working to get a list from SCA corporate of paid members so that the official census of the shire will be known.
- The current Chatelaine would like to step down from the position. She would like to initiate the process for a change in office.
- 1. New Business
  - 1. Date of Future Events and Planning.
- 1. Member of the populace suggested that in November the weather is too cold or rainy for archery tournament.
- Member of the populace suggested that there are too many activities happening earlier in the year, both in the shire and
  events to conflict with in other areas. The timing is related to open space on the kingdom calendar and availability of the
  site.
- Member of the populace suggested an alternate site for an events happening after Labor Day. Kentucky Splash Water Park, Williamsburg. This location may be favorable due to proximity to I75, campsites with electric and water and available bathrooms with showers.
- 4. Member of the populace suggested that it may be beneficial to have a joint event with another group to share costs and get more people to attend.

- 7. Member of the populace suggested that a container should be purchased to keep "gold-key" clothing in to assist the Chatelaine with keeping track of the garb.
- 8. Several members of the populace suggested ways to have more available armor for the shire including Stephanie allowing her armor to be used at practices and purchasing more inexpensive armor. An armor making day for the shire was also suggested.

#### **New Business Discussion**

**Topic**: Expansion of time limits in office for Financial Officers. It has been proposed that we lengthen the term limits for officers who are required to be on bank signatory cards.

**Topic**: Seneschal proposes change to definition of "Quorum" as used in the Shire Charter Quorum (Section 3) is currently defined as: A quorum shall consist of three officers, one of which is the Seneschal or Exchequer, and greater than 50% of the Populace present at the meeting.

Do you support reducing or eliminating the populace requirement to conduct needed business? Populace members in attendance will still be required to cast votes.

#### **SCA In North America**

Sergeant Brannith Marius Some of you recently asked me about the kingdoms of the SCA. Here is a map of the kingdoms in North America. When you attend an inter-kingdom event it is usually between two or more of the kingdoms. Gulf Wars, for example is between Ansteorra and Trimaris, but is held on Gleann Abhann land and Meridias helps with the administration. Pennsic, as another example, is

traditionally between the Middle Kingdom and the East kingdom and is held on Aethelmearc land. Border Raids is between Middle Kingdom and Meridias, and Blackstone Raids is between Aethelmearc and the Middle Kingdom. There are several other large events "out West" that involve Kingdoms in that area. If there is an event that is more "local" (non-inter kingdom) then it is usually between baronies or regions or involve a theme (say Norse vs Celtic or something like that). Such as the one region of the Middle Kingdom versus some other region of the Middle Kingdom.

In the beginning there was only one Kingdom, then the East was created and then Middle Kingdom. It progressed from there. After a certain area of a kingdom gets enough members it can form a principality. A principality is a semi-autonomous area of a Kingdom that may eventually "break away" and form it's own Kingdom. At one point the areas that are now Calontir, Northshield, and Ealdormere were all part of the Middle Kingdom. Gleann Abhann was part of Meridias and Aethelmearc was part of the East Kingdom. There are many more examples of this. Currently several Kingdoms have principalities that may some day "break off" into their own kingdom. This includes West Kingdom, An Tir, Artemisia, Atenveldt and Drachenwald (Europe). The Kingdom of An-tir has very recently split up into An-tir and Avacal (*CLICK HERE* for map)
