1. Program Description— CodeForChange is a 10-Week Committed Internship Program
Beginning in May and lasting until August: CodeForChange interns will attend 12 work meetings each
month, 2 each week. These meetings will be focused on expanding your computer science and
entrepreneurship knowledge. Furthermore, you will apply the content you learn to your respective
capstone projects. After being paired with a real-life business client, CodeForChange Interns will receive
a capstone project to complete over the duration of the program. The teams' goal is to complete this
project successfully and efficiently for the business client.

All meetings will be conducted virtually through Zoom.

- Tuesday Meetings: 12:00 4:00 PM
 - During Tuesday meetings, CodeForChange participants will run through intern curriculum to learn the necessary content to succeed in their respective internships. UNL professors have created this curriculum to ensure that interns have all the proper utensils to complete the business's project.
- Thursday Meetings: 12:00 4:00 PM
 - During Thursday meetings, interns will apply content learned during Tuesday meetings to their respective internship projects.
- Separate Team Meeting: 'chosen by interns'
 - The timings of these meetings are chosen by students; however, the timings
 must be communicated to the mentors to ensure that they are available to attend
 the meeting as well. All team members are expected to be present at this
 meeting, just like any other meeting.

Mentors

 During all three meetings; students will be guided by undergraduate students from University of Nebraska-Lincoln. These mentors are computer science majors at UNL and are part of an organization called Computer Science Ambassadors. The guidance will occur virtually through Zoom meetings.

Intern Teams

- These teams will be created to maximize efficiency by comparing the strengths and weaknesses of every student
- Each team formed will be paired with a real-life client who will assign a capstone project for their respective teams.
- These capstone projects will consist of problems that the clients face on a daily basis.
- Students will be given the task of solving the capstone projects efficiently through utilizing the computer science and entrepreneurship skills taught by the UNL Faculty.

Certificates of Completion

 Certificates will be given to students who successfully finish the capstone projectq.

2. Transportation and Virtual Internships



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- For this project CodeForChange is enabling students to travel from rural Nebraska to participate in our projects.
- We are also enabling students to participate in CodeForChange virtually through videos calls.
- The expectations for virtual interns will be the same. Attendance will be of utmost priority, along with participation and work ethic.

3. CodeForChange Launch Day

- This meeting will provide CodeForChange participants an opportunity to meet their clients and find out what their internship capstone project is. Teams will be formed at this event, thus attendance is required. They will also be able to meet the CodeFroChange and YEC executive team.
