*Hazard Codes	Definition	Examples
T	Toxic (acute or delayed)	Poisons, irritants, carcinogens, teratogens
F	Ignitable	Flammable, Combustion Liquid, Pyrophoric, Oxidizer; flash point <140°F
R	Reactive	Unstable Reactive, Organic Peroxide, Water Reactive, explosive potential
C	Corrosive	liquid with pH <2.0 or >12.5
