Prayer Meeting Week 1: Spiritual Needs of the Church

Sanctification (Matt. 6:9-13; 1 Thess. 3:11-13, 4:9-10; 2 Cor. 7:1)

- Pray for holiness: “As obedient children, do not be conformed to the passions of your former ignorance, but as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, since it is written, “You shall be holy, for I am holy.” 1 Peter 1:14-16
- Pray for growth: “Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.” 2 Peter 3:18
- Pray for sanctification: “Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.” John 17:17

Unity and Love (Eph. 4:1-3; John 13:34-35; Eph. 4:32; 1 Cor. 1:10)

- Pray for unity: “I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment.” 1 Cor. 1:10
- Pray for love: “A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.” John 13:34-35
- Pray for peace: “Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.” Eph. 4:31-32

Church Discipline (1 John 1:9, Gal. 6:1-2, Matt. 18:15-20)

- Pray for confession of sin and repentance: “Confess your sins to one another and pray for one another.” James 5:16
- Pray that we would help each other repent: “If anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted.” Galatians 6:1-2

Teaching and Doctrine (1 Tim. 4:16; 2 Tim. 2:15)

- Pray we would love sound doctrine: ““For the time will come when they will not tolerate sound doctrine; but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance with their own desires, and they will turn their ears away from the truth and will turn aside to myths.” 2 Tim. 4:3-4
- Pray for faithful teaching: “Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.” 2 Tim. 2:15
- Pray for faithful leaders: “Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity. Until I come, devote yourself to the public reading of Scripture, to exhortation, to teaching...Practice these things, immerse yourself in them, so that all may see your progress. Keep a close watch on

yourself and on the teaching. Persist in this, for by so doing you will save both yourself and your hearers.” 1 Timothy 4:12-16

Sunday Service (1 Tim. 4:12-16; Eph. 5:18-20; Psalm 100)

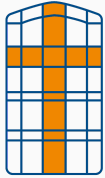

- Pray that we worship God with reverence and awe: “Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire.” Hebrews 12:28-29
- Pray that we sing joyfully to God and one another: “Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.” Colossians 3:16

Salvation of the lost (Rom. 9:1-3; 10:1)

- Pray for the salvation of family, friends, and neighbors: “**Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.**” (Romans 10:1)

Church Growth (1 Cor. 14:16, 24-25)

- Pray for the Lord to add to our number: “**And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.**” Acts 2:47
- Pray for the salvation of our visitors: “**But if all prophesy, and an unbeliever or outsider enters, he is convicted by all, he is called to account by all, the secrets of his heart are disclosed, and so, falling on his face, he will worship God and declare that God is really among you.**” (1 Cor. 14:24-25)
- Our visitors: Allyce, Rubi, Annabelle, Ariana, Leo, Paula (husband Juan and son Alex), Marilyn and her children Paula and Anthony.

The Great Commission (Matt. 28:18-20; 1 Pet. 2:9; 2 Tim. 4:5)

For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh.**” (Romans 9:1-3)

Boldness (Col. 4:3-4; Acts 4:23-31)

- Pray that we would have boldness to proclaim Christ: “**And pray for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the Gospel**” (Eph. 6:19)

Urgency

- Pray for urgency in evangelism: “Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God” (2 Cor. 5:20)
- “If sinners be damned, at least let them leap to Hell over our dead bodies. And if they perish, let them perish with our arms wrapped about their knees, imploring them to stay. If Hell must be filled, let it be filled in the teeth of our exertions, and let not one go unwarned and unprayed for.” Charles Spurgeon

Fear of the Lord

- Pray that we would fear the Lord: “For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil. Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we persuade others.” (2 Cor. 5:10-11)

Clarity and Preparation

- Pray that we would preach the gospel clearly and accurately: “Pray...that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak.” (Col. 4:2-4)
- Pray that we would be prepared to share our faith: “In your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect.” (1 Peter 3:15)

Gospel Adornment (Matt. 5:16; Titus 2:10; 1 Pet. 3:1-6)

- Pray that we would adorn the gospel with holy living: “Bondservants are to be submissive to their own masters in everything; they are to be well-pleasing, not argumentative, not pilfering, but showing all good faith, so that in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior.” Titus 2:9-10
- “let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.” (Matt. 5:16)
- “Likewise, wives, be subject to your own husbands, so that even if some do not obey the word, they may be won without a word by the conduct of their wives, when they see your respectful and pure conduct.” (1 Pet. 3:1-2)
- “If the Word does not dwell with power in us, it will not pass with power from us.” – John Owen
- “Remember you are God’s sword—His instrument—I trust a chosen vessel unto Him to bear His name. In great measure, according to the purity and perfections of the instrument, will be the success. It is not great talents God blesses so much as great likeness to Jesus. A holy minister is an awful weapon in the hand of God.” – Robert Murray M’Cheyne

Revival (2 Kings 22-23; Acts 17:26-27; 1 Tim. 2:1-4)

- Pray for revival in our church, Summit, and the Chicagoland area: “Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.” (Ephesians 3:20)
