"Prepare the house"

- Cover exposed pipes outside the house, inside the house, and in the attic
- Keep the thermostat set to the same temperature during day and night.
 - During freezing temperatures, keep a small drip of water flowing through 1 or 2 faucets.

HOW TO STAY WARM

- Use towels or sheets & heavy-duty tape on windows and doors to prevent drafts.
- Tents are made of material that keeps heat in, set up a tent in the warmest room in your home to sleep inside. (Don't light candles inside the tent)
- How to layer clothes for warmth: 1. Base layer (sweat-wicking fabric) 2. An insulating layer (something fluffy/thick to retain heat) 3. The outer layer (shell-like to shield from wind or rain)
 4. Hat or scarves, if you have them.
- When wearing layers avoid cotton and too many layers. Sweat will make you colder.

"Prepare the house"

- Cover up cracks in the windows and exterior walls
- Disconnect any hoses from The outside faucet, and place a faucet cover over it or wrap it up in towels
- Bring pets and any potted plants inside. Cover any outdoor plants
- Locate the water main and know how to turn off the water in the house.
 Call a professional plumber for assistance if needed.

"Prepare the humans"

- > 3-day supply of non-perishable food
- > Lots of blankets & warm clothes
- > 1 gallon of water per day for each person and pet
- > First Aid Kit
- Flash light
- Medications (ice in a cooler if needed)
- > Battery packs
- > Charge all electronics
- > Please find a way to monitor carbon monoxide from any car or generator being used for heat

HOW TO STAY WARM OUTDOORS

- If at all possible, call 211 to find a warming shelter near you so that you don't have to stay outdoors.
- Dress in layers for warmth: 1. Base layer (sweatwicking fabric) 2. An insulating layer (something fluffy/thick to retain heat) 3. The outer layer (shell-like to shield from wind or rain). 4. Wear a hat & scarves if available.
- Insulate if needed with newspapers in your pockets or other tighter clothing.
- Do not put any type of fire in a tent/enclosed structure.
- Use a mat/blanket/cardboard to keep your body separated from the cold ground.
- If pets get cold, put socks on their feet or any clothing you have that will fit them.
