FMS Ski and Snowboard Club is for students in all grades who:

The ski/snowboard program includes five one hour lessons and lift ticket at Jiminy Ski Resort in Hancock Massachusetts. A sixth night of "free ski/snowboard" is included in the package. *No experience is necessary* to join FMS Ski and Snowboard Club since lessons are provided for all ability levels. Participants are required to attend the weekly lesson clinics; attendance will be taken. Trips will be on *Thursday evenings*, immediately after dismissal.

Bus transportation via charter bus is included in the package price.

Weather permitting, the dates for this year are:

Thursday, January 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th Thursday, February 5th, 12th (Contingent snow day replacement date - Feb 26)

Buses depart from FMS at 3:17 P.M. and return to FMS at 9:00 P.M. All parents must make arrangements to pick up their child on time. In the event of a snow day, ski club will be canceled and rescheduled for a later date.
