

Guidelines for adding new problems in Fontainebleau

Grade:

No need to specify the “Grade System” as FB (i.e. Fontainebleau). The “Grade Context” FR (i.e. French) is automatically assigning the ‘Fontainebleau Scale’ for a boulder.

Name:

- If the problem is only known as “Circuit Number” (e.g. Red 1) that should be registered as the name of the problem.
- If the problem has both a “Name” and a “Circuit Number” (e.g. L’acrobate or Red 1), then the “Name” (i.e. L’acrobate) should be registered as the name of the problem and the “Circuit Number” (i.e. Red 1) as an alternative (AKA) name.
