

Terms of Service

General

- By commissioning me you agree to my Terms of Service as well as acknowledge them.
- As the artist, I have the right to refuse a commission request without reason.
- If a commissioner is rude in any way he/she may be rejected and refunded.

Payment

- I accept USD money through PayPal for payments only.
- The commissioner must pay at least half up front and then the other half after I have shown them the sketch and they have approved it.

Refunds

- I have the right to refuse a refund for any reason.
- If the commissioner wants a refund there may be a short wait time. (That day - 2 weeks)
- Refunds will have a deducted % if I have shown the sketch to the commissioner. (25% at the sketch phase up to 80% depending on how far I have gotten.)
- The commissioner may **NOT** have a refund if the commission is almost completed. (When I'm working in the last phase of said commission. For example, that would be coloring if the commissioner only wanted flat colors or shading if they wanted a fully colored and shaded commission.)

Deadlines

- The commissioner may ask for a certain deadline for the commission to be completed by. I will try to accommodate but may deny the request if I deem it to be too difficult to meet.

Edits/Changes

- If the commissioner wants something changed or edited it will cost a small fee depending on the difficulty. (This only applies after the initial sketch has been approved by the commissioner.)

Distribution

- Commissioners are allowed to use and post their commission for any personal uses they want as long as credit to me is given for the work.
- Commissioners are however, **NOT** allowed to sell the commission in any form for profit.
- Commissioners may also ask for the commission to not be posted in my gallery if they wish as long as I am given credit for the work.

Other

- Commissioners are **NOT** allowed to blur, cover, or remove the watermark/signature for whatever reason unless cropping the image for personal use within reason. Ex: Avatars, Banner, etc. In which case, I just ask that I am credited for the work.
