User Submitted Questions

- Q: are all future events going to be completely new or will some events return/become annual events? is it hard coming up with event ideas? how far in advance are events planned?
 - A: Some events you'll find to become Voltra traditions with a spin on them or a new storyline. (ie. reaping ritual) The Characters from events may make appearances as well.

It's not necessarily difficult to come up with ideas - we pretty much have a stew pot of ideas that all staff contribute to. The hardest part is consolidating the ideas for what makes most sense for the event.

Typically we try to start discussing event ideas a few months in advance.

- Q: Any updates on a possible dream avatar maker?
 - A: Not at this time.
- Q: What inspired you to create Voltra?
 - A: Long story short- I decided to start up a new avatar community after I noticed other communities failing due to matters outside of the community members' control. I too would be left without a community to share my art and interests with, so I decided to start my own project.

The initial concepts of Voltra have evolved so much since I began working on it in 2014. I'm so proud of what our staff has accomplished; helping Voltra blossom into the beautiful city and expanding world it is becoming. (Fozzy)

- Q: Will you keep adding NPCs? Won't named with V end someday? Or you'll just put a V before any name, like Vozzy
 - A: We currently don't have any plans to introduce new NPCs. Typically we introduce NPCs with the intention that they have a role on the website, being a shopkeeper, announcer, or feature. So as the site grows and the Voltra storyline unravels we may introduce more NPCs. You may see more NPCs that are not the main Voltra cast who appear during events.
