Dance Leadership - Level 5

General information for candidates

The purpose of the Dance Leadership course is to enable candidates to develop a range of dance and choreographic skills, whilst also developing skills for life such as leadership, communication and teamwork. Candidates develop and reflect on technical and creative skills through practical learning. They plan and deliver sessions and events to a range of nursery, primary and secondary pupils.

You will complete 4 Units in this course:

In the **Leadership An Introduction Unit**, learners will find out information about leadership and reach conclusions as to what makes an effective leader. They will then evaluate their own potential for leadership.

In the **Leadership in Practice Unit** you will develop your abilities as a leader through practical experience. You will lead an aspect of the work and see it through. This will help you learn what makes an effective leader. You may in future be able to use these skills further either in employment or in your own social time.

In the **Personal Development: Self and Community Unit**, learners will aim to improve their self-reliance and confidence. They will develop their interpersonal skills as they work with others to participate in a group project in the context of one or more communities.

In the **Personal Development: Practical Abilities Unit**, learners will aim to improve their self-reliance and confidence by demonstrating their practical abilities while participating in one or more projects.

In general, the course will:

- build the confidence that learners have in their own leadership abilities
- help learners to develop the leadership skills and values necessary for working cooperatively with others
- help learners to understand the impact they can have on others and on the success of an activity
- encourage reflective learning
- contribute to enhancing the self esteem and self awareness of learners in relation to the contribution they can make to society
