Robert Jay Rowen, M.D., is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of Johns Hopkins University and the University of California San Francisco School of Medicine, acquiring double board certifications (and recertifications) in Family Practice, and Emergency Medicine, and additionally in Clinical Metal Toxicology. He is affectionately known as “The Father of Medical Freedom” for pioneering the nation’s first statutory protection for alternative medicine in 1990, overcoming organized medicine’s vociferous opposition. Two years later, Alaska’s governor Hickel appointed him to a term on the Alaska State Medical Board against again vicious opposition of organized medicine. The appointment survived a legislative battle due to overwhelming public support.

He is internationally known and published for his clinical practice and teaching in ozone therapy, as well as all aspects of integrative medicine.

In October 2014, he traveled to Sierra Leone bringing ozone therapy to the Ebola epidemic. His team cured 5 of 5 people a 100% recovery rate, published in the African Journal of Infectious Diseases: Vol 10, No 1 (2016).

He is the longest continuous user of ozone and oxidation therapies in North America.
