

Test Correction Guidelines and Directions

To show your knowledge of these topics, you may choose to do optional test corrections. They need to follow the requirements below and be submitted on or before the deadline posted on the blog.

To earn one point for each multiple choice you answered incorrectly, identify the correct answer and write 2-3 sentences (that use proper grammar and spelling) explaining why it is correct. To earn the point, you need to use 1-2 additional, relevant, specific facts in your explanation.

All answers must be completed on separate paper. Please either write neatly or type, and submit stapled to the front of the original test.

If you are in the A level class and earned a 30/40 or below, you may choose to correct up to 3 multiple choice questions and earn up to 2 additional points on the short answer.

If you are in the B level class, you may choose to correct up to 5 multiple choice questions and earn up to 4 points on the short answer.
