Spectrum Alliance will be meeting every other Wednesday in 2313 (next meeting is 4/3), from 3:30-4:30pm. Please come and show your support!

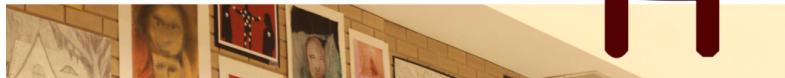
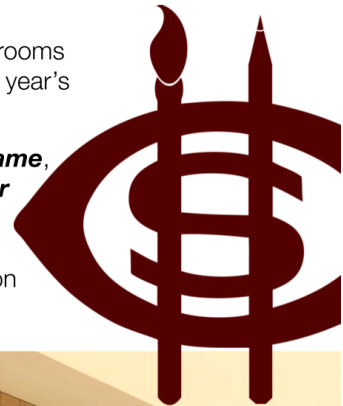


CALL FOR ARTWORK
