# Class of 2024 SENIOR INFO DIPLOMAS, TRANSCRIPTS, & CLEARING FINES

### Check out the BHS Registrar's website

<u>Diploma Info</u> Your diploma and transcripts should be mailed within three months of graduation. If your address is different from what we have in the system, please provide us with your new mailing address by June 30, 2024 <u>using this form</u>\*. Please note: The name listed in your school records will be how the name will appear on your diploma, so make sure the spelling is correct. If you do not receive your diploma by September 2024, you may need to come to the Registrar's office in D-173, in the event that it was returned or being held due to debts. <u>Outstanding Debts & Book Fines</u> Students must clear all financial obligations (including book debts, athletic equipment, etc.) to the school prior to receiving their free graduation tickets and their diploma. Seniors won't receive their high school diplomas until they return all their textbooks and library books. The BHS library is open for returning books Monday - Friday 8:00 am - 4:30pm. The BHS Library will be understanding of any difficulty with replacing lost or missing books, so consider proactively contacting <u>Nicole Fitzhugh</u>, Textbook Room Clerk. Seniors are able to check their outstanding fines during lunchtime and after school in the library. Please pay your fines on the BHS Student Store.

**Final Transcript Request Procedure** All transcripts will be sent based on your response to the <u>Final Official Transcript Request Form 2024</u>. Please note that academic counselors can assist with transcript requests to schools that are listed on the Common App. The Registrar's Office along with the Counselors and the College Center will work with that report and use the information that you provided to determine the college you will be attending in the Fall. This means that you MUST be accurate about your college(s) on this report. You will NOT need to do any request individually. Transcripts will be sent out as soon as they are finalized. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to reach out to the <u>BHS Registrar</u> or your assigned counselor.

<u>Course Pre-Approval</u> Seniors planning to take classes outside of Berkeley High School or Independent Study Program, and wish to receive grades and credit for the course <u>MUST</u> get prior permission from your Counselor and Registrar. If you take the course without prior approval it will <u>NOT</u> be reflected on your high school transcript.

Free & Reduced Meals Verification Families should complete a paper application or do so online with the EZ Meal App in order to receive benefits under the free & reduced lunch program. If determined to qualify, students can receive discounts to school events (prom, graduation, etc.) among other testing discounts if they have completed forms on file with B.U.S.D. Once determined to qualify for free & reduced meals, Nutrition Services will send a paper copy of the eligibility letter to the mailing address on the application or by email. The email notification will show as "noreplyetrition.com". Please make sure to check your spam file in your emails. To receive the discount, this paper copy or digital photo of the eligibility letter will be shown to school officials overseeing the school event.

If a household needs another letter they should contact Sara Leon either through <u>saraleon@berkeley.net</u>. This information is protected by right to privacy so we are not able to provide this information to minors or someone other than the head of household through email. Nutrition Services require up to 3–5 days to process their request as these do not tend to come in one at a time.

### Class of 2024 SENIOR INFO **EXPECTATIONS & ACTIVITIES**

**Expectations**: We would like to finish this year on the same positive note that we have had all year, and we would like to remind seniors of a few behavior expectations. Juniors & Seniors may not be allowed to participate in school activities if any of the following apply:

- 30 or more period unverified absences for any class from August 2023 March 2024. Suspension for any discipline matter (For prom, this policy will be in effect after February 1). The exception to this rule is to attend make-up tutorials; for each 1 hour of tutoring you can earn credit for 1 unexcused absence. You will need to attend as many tutorials as is needed to have under 30 unexcused period absences.
- Juniors & Seniors who violate any school policy that causes an out-of-school suspension will forfeit all rights for participating in graduation activities, including prom. Final decisions about exclusions will be reviewed by the admin team for review and determination about exclusion from prom.

<u>Senior Activities</u> We have a Senior Spellout planned for September and hope to build from there. Updates will be sent to your student email or you can follow <u>@juicethejackets</u> or <u>@bhs24seniors</u> on Instagram.

<u>Senior Sunrise & Spellout</u> We are working to secure an event date on a late start Monday. We will send out the info on the bulletin, Instagram and via email when it is approved. The 2024 spell out will take place in the main courtyard at the steps of the Community Theater.

<u>Senior Portraits</u> Prestige Portraits by Lifetouch will offer two more chances for taking senior portraits on campus in the fall. The next two sets of appointments will be during the week of September 18 and the week of November 13 (*date was moved up in October*).

For the last round of on-campus portraits, you will need to schedule your own appointment during the week of November 13-17. The portraits will be taken in the East Gallery of the Community Theater. This is the last on-campus session...<u>SCHEDULE YOUR APPOINTMENT HERE</u>

If you need to reschedule or have not gotten an email 2-3 weeks beforehand, please reach out to byarea@lifetouch.com or call 1-877-825-7922. You will most likely need to book an appointment at their Hayward office by winter break at the latest. \*Reminder\* BHS Students must use Prestige Portraits to have their senior portrait appear in the yearbook. LifeTouch will provide the dress, tuxedo, or cap & gown for your yearbook portrait. If you select multiple backgrounds or outfits, please bring more outfits as desired to your session. If you are unable to take a portrait, your school photo will be included in the yearbook. If you have already taken your senior portraits, please contact 1-800-736-4775 with any questions.

Prom 2024 plans to be a memorable evening with the city skyline as a beautiful backdrop. Guests can expect light food options, activities, and free photobooth pictures. This will be a Class of 2024 & 2025 exclusive event, meaning that no students from the Class of 2026 or 2027 may attend. **Prom Policy**: In order to attend prom, students should not be involved in conduct that violates education code and school rules from January 1 - March 18. If there is a violation of the education code and school rules you will be excluded from prom. The attendance office sends students who have 30+ unexcused absences a letter home notifying them that they cannot attend Prom.

You can earn yourself off the prom exclusion list by showing improvement in your attendance. You will need to complete a 2-week attendance card that you can pick up from the attendance office. You must have no unexcused period absences or CUTs during your 2 week attendance card and it must be completed before March 11th (end of quarter 3). You can attend tutoring with teachers or in the CCC. For each hour of tutorial, you will earn 1 period of credit. If you can get your unexcused absences count under 30, you will be removed from the Prom Exclusion list. **Tickets:** All tickets will be at <u>BHS Student Store</u>. There are no ticket transfers or reselling of tickets for any reason. Be prepared to show a recent photo ID card at the door. Any guest that attempts to enter using a ticket with mismatched names and ID numbers will not be allowed entry or be able to request a refund. Please understand that there will not be refunds issued for prom if you are unable to attend or get removed from the event. By purchasing the ticket you are agreeing to abide by the rules of Berkeley High, Berkeley Unified School District, SF City Hall and the city of San Francisco.

**Discounted Tickets**: For BHS students who qualify, they can purchase discounted tickets at \$50 in person only. Students must show your current school year eligibility letter (paper/email/ pic) from B.U.S.D. Nutrition Services to verify eligibility. Please see page 3 for details on how to qualify.

**Guest Passes & Dance Conduct:** Non-BHS Guest Pass Forms must be submitted before or at the time of purchase. Only guests 20 years of age or younger will be admitted to Prom. *Guest Pass Forms are accepted until March* 16 and are available online only. <u>Click here for the Guest Pass Form</u>. You will be sent a passcode once the guest pass is approved. Guests must also show a recent photo ID card at the door.

**Security**: All guests will pass through a metal detector & security screening managed by SF Sheriffs. Be prepared to show a recent photo ID card at the door. Please do not bring large overnight bags, gum, food or beverage, drugs, weapons, among other illegal items. Contact Mr. V if you have a dietary need, prescription, or other need that may fall on the prohibited item list.

**Sobriety:** For your safety, any guest suspected of being under the influence or in possession of an illegal or controlled substance, either when arriving or during the Prom, will have their parents/guardians notified and will be required to leave the premises. Parents/Guardians will be responsible for picking the student up as all school policies and subsequent consequences will be enforced. Let's have a joyous and safe celebration!

**<u>Details on Cap & Gowns</u>** Caps and gowns will be shipped directly to your desired shipping address.

- 1. Each gown is marked with the student's name, but be sure that you have all items in your package.
- 2. Purchased caps and gowns are individuals' to keep and do not need to be returned.
- 3. Decorations can only be applied to the top of the cap.

Cap, Gown, & Tassel Loaner Program Achievers Inc. and BUSD have agreed to begin a loaner program for cap, gown, and tassel loaner for seniors to wear during the commencement ceremony. Please understand that per Berkeley Unified School District's (BUSD) requirements, this cap, gown, and tassel, must be returned immediately following the ceremony. Under Ed Code section 48904, failure to return each of these three items (cap/gown/tassel) may result in the student's diploma being held by BUSD and not being issued until the District has received payment for these items. In order to set up a loaner, please visit <a href="https://www.graduationorder.com">www.graduationorder.com</a> and enter the code <a href="https://www.graduationorder.com">bhs510</a> You will select "Loan" after logging into the website. Please return your loaner cap, gown and tassel immediately following the ceremony. If you forget to return your loaner cap, gown, and tassel after graduation ends, please return these items to the registrar's office at BHS the following week. The deadline to request a LOANER cap & gown is March 1, 2024.

We will share graduation updates via student email, BHS e-tree, the BHS website, this section of <u>the senior information</u> <u>page</u> among other means.

<u>Tickets</u> It is assumed that all graduating students will attend the ceremony. All graduating students from BHS, BIS & BTA will receive six (6) tickets for graduation. Please complete the <u>RSVP form</u> by May 1st \*form opens late March.

Every person attending, regardless of age, must have a ticket for entrance.

<u>Ticket Distribution</u> We will distribute six (6) tickets to all graduating students after the June 3 grad meeting. An alternative pick up time will be announced closer to graduation. All outstanding debts must be cleared before tickets can be distributed.

**Grad Meeting** There will be a meeting for all Class of 2024 Graduates in the Donahue Gym on Monday, June 3rd during the school day. We will review the graduation plan, share any last minute updates, and then distribute tickets. <u>Please preview the presentation by clicking here\*</u>. \*to be updated May 2024.

<u>Additional Tickets</u> We encourage graduates to ask their classmates if they have any extra tickets. We do not have plans to release additional tickets beyond the six allotted tickets.

**Health & Safety** Following each ceremony, all guests will wait for the graduates to recess before exiting the bleachers.

<u>Access for Persons with Disabilities</u> Jacket Stadium is wheelchair accessible and seating is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). <u>Please complete this form</u>\* for families that may need special accommodations for parking and/or more easily accessible seating. If needed, contact <u>toniacoleman@berkeley.net</u>. We will do our best to accommodate ADA seating requests in the first three rows and top row of the bleachers. \*form available April 2024

<u>Seating</u> Seating is general admission above the first three rows of ADA seating. Jacket Stadium will open up one hour prior to each ceremony.

<u>Bag Policy</u> Only <u>clear tote bags</u>, plastic storage bags, or small clutch bags are allowed inside Jacket Stadium. Guests will not be permitted inside the graduation with bags.

<u>Prohibited Items</u> Guests and graduates are not allowed to bring in items that could obstruct views of the ceremony or seating at Jacket Stadium on the day of the ceremony such as flowers, large signs, balloons, etc. Guests will be instructed to return any prohibited item back to their vehicle or leave them unattended at the entrance gate. Personal sun protection is allowable provided that it doesn't block any views of the ceremony.

<u>Graduation Day</u> Seniors should plan to report to the Donahue Gym 60 minutes prior to the ceremony start time. Caps, gowns, and tassels should be worn at graduation. Achievers Inc. will be present in front of the Donahue Gym from 9:00 am - 5:00 pm for all of your graduation needs. See page 6 of the senior Info for Cap & Gown details.

**Parking** It is encouraged for guests to walk, shuttle or take public transportation to the event. There are many nearby paid parking spots available. The Bancroft & Durant lots will be reserved for staff and ADA parking.

**Photos** Professional photography will be made available to the Class of 2024 within a short time after all ceremonies are completed. The photos will be available to download for free or for print at an additional cost. There will not be a need to move up in the bleachers during the ceremony to take photos. In addition, all ceremonies will be recorded by a film crew that is livestreaming the event which you can watch from the bleachers or on replay at a later time.
