Eric Brown was a 1983 graduate and a member of the 1988 EHS Athletic Hall of Fame class. He was a seven-time letterman in wrestling, football and track. Brown's top accomplishments were achieved in his wrestling career: He was on the varsity roster all four years, held a 26-1 record his senior year and was the team MVP in 1982-1983.

Additionally, Brown qualified for state his senior year, and was the Team Captain. In football, he was on the All-State Team and All Metro Team his senior year. He led the team in defensive statistics and ended his senior season with 130 tackles. In track, he set the freshman low hurdle record and set the Belleville East Relays long jump relay record. His sophomore year, he set the

J.V. mile relay record. He played Football and Wrestling at Elmhurst College. Once In college, Brown held a 20-6-2 record for wrestling and placed third in conference freshman year. He went on to join the military and had a career in the Air Force.
