

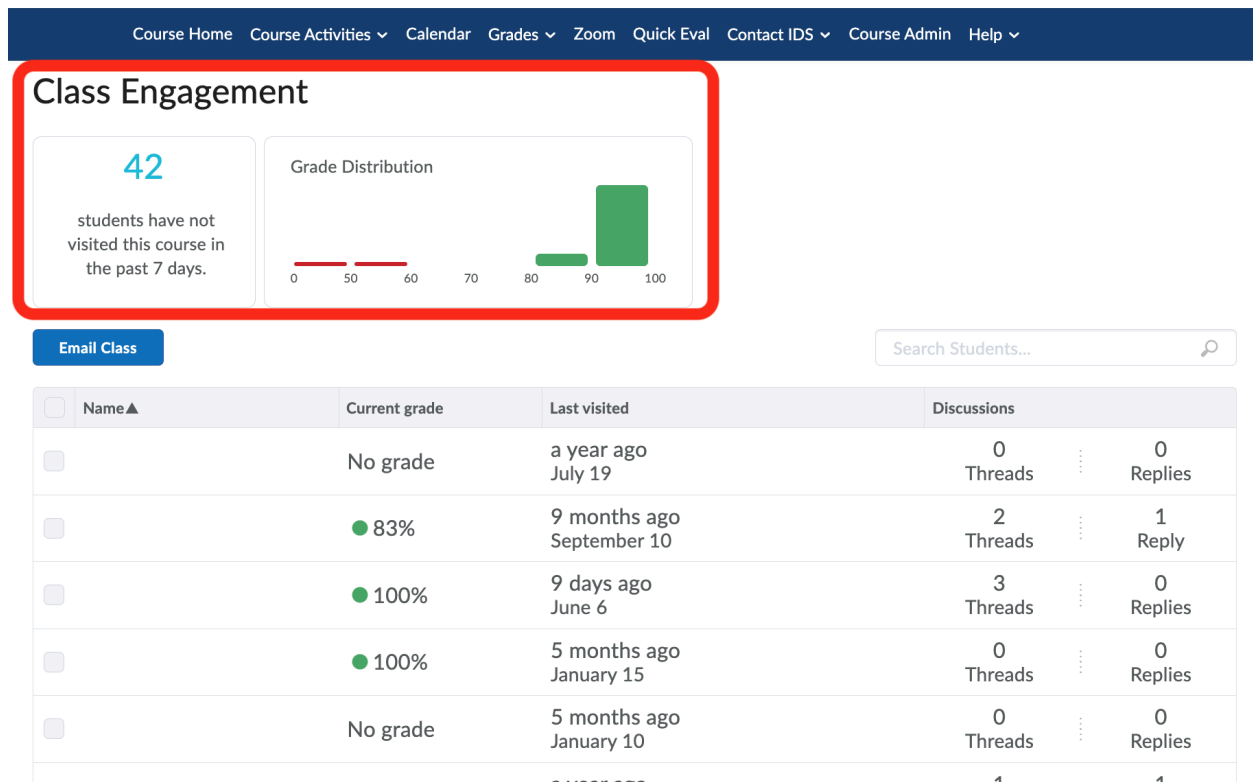

When you are on the Class Engagement page, you will see a visual summary of grade distribution and student access in the past 7 days (or rather, how **many students have NOT** accessed the course in the last 7 days).
