Podcast Episode Reference Guide

You can quickly find the podcast episode that you would like to listen to. The lesson based podcasts are always written in the format code below:

FIRST LETTER = SUBJECT CODE ((M=Math,E=ESL, R=Reading,. S=Social Studies, C=Science, L=Language Arts)

FIRST NUMBER = LESSON NUMBER CODE (2 = 2nd lesson in that subject)

FOUR-CHARACTER MIDDLE CODE = QUICK REFERENCE TO SUBJECT AREA (Easier to locate when browsing. MATH, SOCS (Social Studies), SCIENCE, ESL, LANGUAGE arts, READING)

LAST NUMBER = RECOMMENDED LEVEL (example: 5 = ABE5 or higher)

STUDY AREA (example: Economics, Biology, World History)

LESSON TOPIC (example: Supply/Demand, Parts of a Cell, French Revolution)

S3 = Social Studies, 3rd lesson

SOCS = Social Studies (To find the subject more easily)

3 = Recommended for level 3 and higher

World History = Study area

Colonization = Lesson topic

Also, the episode number in front should correspond to the episodes that Alexa indexes. So, if you ask Alexa to play Episode 15, it should find the example above.

All logged time should be turned in weekly. Be sure to record the date and your initials beside each episode you listen to in the week. The top of the page should have your name and CRN (or teacher if you don't know your CRN). Give this sheet to your instructor at the end of each week. LTC Adult Education Podcasts not in English aren't listed, but if you speak that language and listen to that podcast, you may write it in for credit.

Please enjoy the podcast episodes and follow any additional activities provided by your instructor.
