Comprised of over 100 volunteers, it is one of the largest and most successful student organisations in Australia. The UQMS works closely with the UQ Faculty of Medicine as well as local, state, and national bodies to ensure that all UQ medical students benefit from a student built community like no other. Above all, the UQMS values inclusivity, diversity, integrity, connectivity, fulfilment, and excellence throughout their actions, events, and activities.

About Convenors of the UQMS

Convenors are the event organisers and initiative coordinators of the UQMS. Be it as an individual or in a team capacity, convenors plan, prepare, and execute a wide array of academic, social, wellbeing, professional development, and community events and initiatives. Convenors belong to UQMS subcommittees corresponding to a Management Committee portfolio and can be elected or appointed, individually or in teams, generally for one year terms.

As a UQMS Convenor, the office bearer is expected to:

- Actively contribute to the day-to-day planning and implementation of their event and/or initiative;
- Dedicate themselves and remain committed to effective teamwork and the success of their event and/or initiative for the duration of their term, including handover;
- Adhere to all UQMS Rules, Bylaws and Policies, and comply with all plans enacted at a portfolio level; and
- Provide regular reports and updates to their corresponding Management Committee member, and be advised by them where appropriate through open communication channels.

About the Role

Trephine is the annual journal, and flagship publication, of the University of Queensland Medical Society. Established in 1941, Trephine aims to provide readers with a vibrant, topical and informative insight into life as a medical student with all the year's highs and lows. Trephine enjoys a broad readership that includes current UQ medical students and



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staff, in addition to practicing medical professionals who form the alumni of the UQ Faculty of Medicine. Furthermore, graduating students retain their copy as an important memento of their journey through medical school. The diverse readership of Trepine represents a substantial proportion of the current and future medical professionals in Queensland.
