

Registration of Players to Teams.

All players must be registered to a team on FAI Connect before they are eligible to play for that team.

If they are not registered to a team, for any reason, they are not eligible to play.

All players must be added to a team at least the day before he is eligible play a game.

A player can only be registered to one team in his age group.

if there are more than one team in his age group, he can only play for the team he is registered to - He cannot move between the teams in his age group.

However, he can move to another team in the same club in his age group during a transfer window (internal transfer format).

He can move to another club also during a transfer window (subject of course to CSL Rule 1A) but will be cup tied if it applies.

A player can play one age above his age group (e.g. an U13 can play U14).

He must be registered with the U14 team also to be eligible to play with that team.

if a club has more than one team in the higher age group (e.g. U14), he can only play with one team, the one he is registered with, in the higher age group. He cannot move from that team in the higher age group for the whole season, not even during a transfer window.

NO Premier or Division 1 player can play in any of the U12/U13/U14/U15 or U16 Founders Cups (for D2 and below teams), the U12 Kevin Dillon Cup (for D7 and below teams), the U13 Jerry Hurley Cup (for D7 and below teams) or the U14 Pat Cronin Cup (for D7 and below teams).

At the U11 age group, no team can have more than five U10 players registered. No U10 player can be removed from the U11 team and replaced once he is assigned to the U11 team.

At the U12 age group, no team can have more than five U11 players registered. No U11 player can be removed from the U12 team and replaced once he is assigned to the U12 team.
