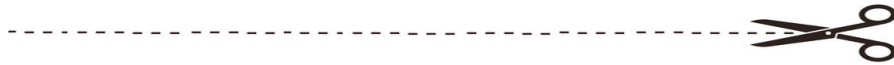

Cell phone Policy
