More about the 5K:

October 26, 2024 at 10:00am - start/end outside Bustad Hall at WSU.

There will be handouts, and signage at the start/end of the event about Rabies prevention in the United States, as well as around the world. A team member from the Rabies Free Africa Campaign will also kick off this event by welcoming everyone and explaining more about the Campaign and Rabies prevention.

The run will go up and down Grimes Way and will include a one mile loop around the WSU Arboretum. There will be markings/tags along the way to keep people on course. The one mile section of the 5K around the WSU Arboretum run will be a "zombie loop" where zombies (your friendly neighborhood vet students and others) will be eagerly waiting to snack on your brains!

Each participant who chooses to run the zombie loop will receive a capture the flag belt and attempt to make it through the loop with their belt intact! Can you make it out alive??

At the end of the race there will be a prize drawing for lots of amazing gift baskets/prizes donated by our even more amazing sponsors! Each person present at the race will receive 1 ticket for the prize drawing. If you are able to run in the event and return to the registration desk at the end of the run with your belt intact after the zombie loop, you will receive 2 additional tickets for the prize drawing. We will also be giving away extra tickets for the prize drawing for anyone who shows up in a Halloween costume!
